The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, March 6, 2006 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. The minutes of the February 27, 2006 meeting were read and approved.

**06-130** Motion by Mr. Ron Moore and seconded by Mr. Dean Cain to approve the minutes from February 27, 2006.

The commissioners reported on their activities from the preceding week of February 27, 2006.

On Monday, Commissioners Cain and Moore attended the SEO Joint Solid Waste Board meeting in Caldwell while Commissioner Shriver attended the Osteopathic Heritage Foundation's meeting on the homelessness initiative in the Chamber Room of the Riecker Complex.

On Tuesday, all of the commissioners attended the Morgan County Planning Commission meeting.

On Thursday, Commissioner Moore attended a CIC call committee meeting.

The commissioners met with John Lanning of RHS Solutions to discuss workers' compensation on Friday.

Mr. Jeff Shaner, OSU Extension Office, reported that Ohio 4-H Week is being held all this week, March 6-10<sup>th</sup>. Ohio 4-H Week finishes up on Saturday with a state wide volunteer meeting in Columbus. Morgan County will be represented with 8 volunteers attending this meeting.

Mr. Shaner also reported that the pesticide applicators training will begin next Monday March 13<sup>th</sup> and that the Livestock Sale Committee and Jr. Leaders will meet this week.

Mrs. Shannon Wells, Director, Community Development, discussed the breakdown of the Osteopathic Heritage Foundation Grant. Mrs. Wells reported that she and Ms. Kelly Caldwell will be attending the training in Columbus for the Homelessness Initiative Continuum of Care. This training will be available to others as well.

Mrs. Wells reported that a public meeting will be held today March 6<sup>th</sup> for the transit program.

Mrs. Wells stated to the commissioners that she would like to have the administrative oversight on the CHIP Grant for 2006-2008. This grant currently is being handled by Washington-Morgan Community Action. Mrs. Wells also noted that Community Action is currently retaining the services of a third-party to handle the Fair Housing associated with this grant. The commissioners will send Community Action a letter regarding the appointment of Shannon Wells to oversee the administrative issues with the CHIP program.

The commissioners signed an agreement with Community Action regarding the CHIP application and administration.

The commissioners agree to appoint the Morgan County Director of Development, Shannon Wells to review the progress of CHIP activities.

The said crossing to be for a 4 inch diameter water line. The construction of this project will begin on about March 8, 2006 and will be completed by April 15, 2006.

The said right a way is to be for a 4" inch diameter waterline. The construction of this project will begin on or about March 8, 2006 and will be completed by April 1, 2006.

The commissioners are in receipt the balance of grant funds for the Wellness and Help Me Grow programs for the month of February, 2006 submitted by Carolyn Hanson, Community Action.

Mr. Ray Dingy stopped in the commissioners' office to discuss the number of dog tags sold this year in Morgan County. Mr. Dingy stated that only 2400 dog tags have been sold in this county so far this year. He would like to know why people with dogs that do not purchase tags are not being fined. Mr. Ron Moore responded with the fact that Morgan County does not have the funds available to canvass the county and verify which dogs are licensed and which are not. However, the commissioners are going to look into ways to increase collection rates. Mr. Ray Dingy stated that he would return to the commissioners' office with other residents in three weeks.

Ms. Linda Sheets, Office on Aging, reported that the annual dinner for United Way will be held on March 9<sup>th</sup>. Ms. Sheets also reported that they are having free tax service for seniors at the Senior Center.

The Public Meeting for the Transit Program was held. It was decided that the county will be applying to ODOT for funding.

Ms. Kathy Potteiger, Family & Children First, submitted invoices for payment.

A Public Hearing with Central Ohio Coal Company was held. Mr. Tom Schott and Mr. Gary Miller represented Central Ohio Coal. It was decided that the maintenance period for County Road 11 North and County Road 5 will begin May 1, 2006 and will end April 30, 2007.
