The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, April 10, 2006 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. The minutes of the April 3, 2006 meeting were read and approved.

06-175 Motion by Mr. Ron Moore and seconded by Mr. Dean Cain to approve the minutes from April 3, 2006.

The commissioners reported on their activities from the preceding week of April 3, 2006.

Commissioner Moore and Commissioner Cain met with Mr. John Lanning of RHS Solutions and DJFS employees to discuss Workers' Compensation on Wednesday. Commissioners Moore and Cain attended the ISO 100 classes on Wednesday evening at the EMA offices.

On Thursday, Commissioner Cain attended a special meeting in Nelsonville regarding the Joint Jail.

On Friday, Commissioner Cain, Gary Woodward and Judge Favreau contacted Mr. John Hoopingarner of the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy office and requested that he place a person from his office in Morgan County to answer questions on the property assessment. Mr. Hoopingarner stated that he will place a person in the Clerk of Courts, Mary Gessell's office beginning Monday April 10, 2006. Also on Friday, Commissioner Moore attended the Buckeye Hills-Hocking Valley Development Executive Board Meeting in Marietta.

The commissioners are in receipt of the April, May & June 2006 DJ&FS Mandated Share. The mandated share for the State Fiscal Year 2006 is \$77,717.00. Morgan County is currently being billed for the April-June quarter in the amount of \$19,429.25.

Mr. Jim Ridenour, Director, Job and Family Services, submitted leave request and "cash-in" for forty hours of unused sick leave per the Union Contract Article 11.2.

Mr. Ridenour also submitted a meeting request for himself to attend the Ohio College Access Network (OCAN) Meeting on April 20th in Marietta and for Ms. Pat Wilson to attend the Regional Fiscal Meeting on April 20th in Caldwell.

The commissioners are in receipt of the Monthly Inventory Report Obligations and Securities submitted by Ms. Kaye Tatman, Treasurer.

The commissioners are in receipt of the Monthly Postage report for the month of March.

The commissioners are in receipt the Morgan County Jail Useage for the month of March 2006 submitted by Thomas C. Jenkins, Sheriff.

The commissioners are in receipt of a statement from Ms. Mary Gessel, Clerk of Courts. In the statement Ms. Gessel writes that the state has reimbursed the Capital Improvements Fund for the wiring costs associated with the move of the clerk's office in the amount of \$2719.00.

The commissioners are in receipt of a check from Marietta Memorial Hospital fund in the amount of \$2,000.00 to help cover the costs of installing automatic doors on the Riecker Building.

Ms. Linda Sheets, Director, Office on Aging, submitted invoices for payment and discussed with the commissioners plumbing problems at the Senior Center. Ms. Sheets stated that it has been determined the odor in the offices is linked to the flooring around the toilet. She stated the toilet was not properly installed, and as a result the flooring has weakened. Ms. Sheets will contact Mr. Brent Smith of Buckeye Hills to seek direction on the repairs since the work was done with CDBG Formula Funds.

Ms. Sheets discussed the current gas mileage reimbursement for her department. She would like the current amount of \$0.30 per mile to be increased. She said with the cost of gas and the amount of travel her employees are required to do, the current amount is not enough to cover the cost of gas. The commissioners will check into the legalities of an increase.

Mr. Jim Greer reported to the commissioners on Medical Mutual taking over the flexible spending account for county employees. Mr. Greer determined that the most cost effective way for the county to manage this would be to leave it the way it is. Medical Mutual will add additional costs that would need to be picked up by the county or county employees. Mr. Greer also discussed the addition of a vision program for county employees. The commissioners decided to maintain the current account procedure.

Commissioner Ron Moore was excused at 1:00 PM to attend the Southeastern Solid Waste Meeting in Caldwell.

Ms. Marlys Barbee stopped by the commissioners' office to report that numerous citizens are concerned about the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy assessment. Ms. Barbee stated that she delivered several affidavits of disqualifications to judges in 3 counties with all other eighteen judges receiving the documents as well.

The public hearing for the Graham Farm Development was held. Mr. Jeff McInturf from the Engineer's office reported that all of the lots are over 5 acres except for 3, and those 3 are suitable for development.

The commissioners are in receipt of the 2005 Community Recycling & Litter Prevention Grant Financial Statement.

The commissioners are in receipt of a statement for Help Me Grow TANF for March 2006 prepared by Ms. Carolyn Hanson, Washington-Morgan Community Action. Ms. Hanson also submitted a statement for Wellness for March 2006.

Ms. Shannon Wells, Community Development, reported to the commissioners on the transit program. Ms. Wells stated that during the first week of service under MRDD that the Morgan County Public Transit service provided 22 runs, 19 of which were regular public runs. The commissioners requested that in the future the reports reflect in county and out of county trips.

Ms. Wells reported that 1 vehicle has reported brake problems and over heating problems. The brake problem was identified during the transition.

Ms. Wells reported on the Health Center renovations. Dave's Landscaping is currently providing landscaping services to the Health Department. Their contract is through Genesis and not the county. Ms. Wells went on to report that the Family & Children First office will relocate to the Health Department.

Ms. Wells reported on the handicapped door for the Riecker Building. Two quotes have been received to install the door, Thomas Door Control and Modern Glass.

Ms. Wells went on to discuss the Homelessness Grant. Ms. Wells stated that she would like to have Ms. Kelly Caldwell support her on a temporary basis 1 day a week and paid

by grant funds. Commissioner Cain stated it would be better to hire an additional part time person for this support.

Commissioner Moore returned to the office at 3:30 PM.

The commissioners are in receipt of a request made by Mr. Mark Nesselroad to use the Commons for Morgan Youth Sports. The commissioners are requesting a schedule and proof of insurance.

Mr. Jeff Shaner reported on the CIC meeting being held on Wednesday April 12th. Mr. Shaner also reported that the Ohio EPA would like to meet with the tenants of the Morgan Partnership Growth Complex for a 5 year follow up remediation from the previous owner.

Mr. Shaner also reported that he has looked into the Ag Marketing Grant to see if Morgan County could qualify for funds for an incubator kitchen. Currently Morgan County does not have a certified kitchen available to process food for sale. Mr. Shaner reported that a food servicing license is different from a food processing license.

Mr. Shaner reported that he would be applying for a grant through OSU for the Farmer's Market to promote signage, advertising and possibly secure produce bags.

Mr. Jeff Driggs, County Dog Warden submitted his weekly reports showing he had driven a total of 263 miles for the week of April 8th, picking up a total of 4 dogs 1 of which is still being held, 1 missing from pound, and 2 destroyed.
