

## **MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS RIECKER BUILDING**

The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, April 17, 2006 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. The minutes of the April 10, 2006 meeting were read and approved.

**06-186** Motion by Mr. Ron Moore and seconded by Mr. Dean Cain to approve the minutes from April 10, 2006.

The commissioners reported on their activities from the preceding week of April 10, 2006.

Commissioner Moore attended the Southeast Ohio Joint Solid Waste board meeting in Caldwell on Monday.

On Wednesday, Commissioners Shriver and Cain attended the CIC meeting and after the meeting both commissioners then met with the state auditor's examiners. Also on Wednesday, Commissioner Shriver met with the Xerox representative to discuss office machines. Commissioner Shriver also attended the Council of Government Executive Committee Meeting that was held in Caldwell.

On Thursday, Commissioners Cain and Moore conducted interviews with Terry Robison, EMA, for an assistant for his office and Commissioner Cain met with Sheriff Jenkins concerning the housing of prisoners. Also on Thursday all of the commissioners attended the township meeting held in York Township at the Deavertown School.

On Friday, Commissioner Moore attended a Regional Area Agency on Aging meeting in Marietta and Commissioner Cain contacted Ms. Barb Bradley of the Health Department regarding the open sewer reported by Mr. John Reed.

Mr. Jeff Shaner, OSU Extension Office, reported on the 37/78 corridor project. He discussed the blackout dates established by ODOT for meeting with consultants. Mr. Shaner reported that he would like to meet with a consultant regarding the project, but had not heard back from Ms. Deb Fout with ODOT regarding the legalities of this. If the blackout dates are currently not in effect, then Mr. Shaner will meet with a consultant on Wednesday.

Mr. Shaner reported that the Eastern Ohio Alliance Development Meeting will meet on Friday April 21. Also on Friday, Mr. Shaner reported that there will be an entrepreneur training session in Columbus on Friday, and he will be participating in that meeting.

Mr. Shaner reported that on Tuesday the Entrepreneur Network Meeting will be held. The speaker will focus on helping folks sell items on Ebay.

Mr. Shaner also reported that the Farmers Market will begin on Friday April 21<sup>st</sup>.

Mr. Gene Lyon reported on the lighting problem at the Riecker Complex Rotary Garden on the flagpole. He suggested changing the bulb size for the ballast to work properly and extend the life of the unit.

Mr. John Hill and Mr. Jim Miller met with the commissioners in order to select a site for the Purple Heart Monument. Mr. Hill in the past submitted a picture and description of the monument. The monument is being paid for through donations. It was determined that it will be erected in the Rotary Garden at the Riecker Complex.

Mr. Jim Ridenour, Director, Job and Family Services, submitted meeting requests for the following to attend OJFSDA Annual Training on May 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> in Columbus: Ms. DeeAnn Vandine, Ms. Cathy Apperson, Mr. Sid Richardson, Ms. Linda Newcome, Ms. Mary Woodward, Ms. Kay Drabik and Mr. Jim Ridenour.

Mr. Ridenour submitted a supply request to purchase printed envelopes.

Mr. Ridenour also reported that he will be conducting interviews this week for the Fiscal Officer position.

Mr. Shriver asked Mr. Ridenour about the procedure of using TANF funds to pay for college for those in need. Mr. Shriver stated that Ms. Karen Peters, Washington State Community College, had contacted him regarding lower income students being turned away at the Workforce Development Office. Many of those being turned away are under the age of 23 and are not living with their parents. Mr. Ridenour stated that they should be eligible for assistance.

The Investment Advisory Committee met to discuss the C.D.'s and interest rates. Ms. Kaye Tatman, Treasurer, reported the two C.D.'s matured last week and North Valley received both bids with a rate of 4.80% for 6 months.

Ms. Tatman also reported that 2 C.D.'s will be maturing April 25<sup>th</sup> and that North Valley Bank currently holds both of those. She also reported that the interest rate is currently at 1.40% at First National Bank and 3.21% at Citizens National Bank for NOW checking accounts.

Ms. Linda Sheets, Director, Office on Aging, asked the commissioners if they have any information for her regarding the increase in mileage reimbursement she has requested for her employees. They responded that they had not heard anything from the prosecuting attorney's office.

Ms. Sheets also submitted invoices for payment.

Mr. Carl Williams gave a report to the commissioners regarding the renovations being completed at the fair board office. Mr. Williams reported that the interior wall has been moved and the carpet is installed. The work is being performed by the fair board members.

The commissioners approved a request made by Ms. Kelly Caldwell, Clerk, to take the weeks of May 8<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup> and May 29<sup>th</sup> – June 1<sup>st</sup> off without pay.

Ms. Shannon Wells, Community Development, reported that the transit program completed 26 trips last week, 22 passengers paying fares and 4 Medicaid passengers. She reported that the program is running well and no complaints had been made so far.

Ms. Wells reported that she would be attending the CDBG formula application training being held in Chillicothe on Tuesday. The deadline for applications to be submitted for the CDBG grant is Friday April 21<sup>st</sup>. Ms. Wells reported that as of Monday, only 2 applications had been received.

Ms. Wells asked the commissioners about her being a salary employee versus hourly. She stated that she has kept a log of the additional hours she has worked and wanted to make sure that everyone has the same understanding on how a salary employee is different from an hourly employee.

Ms. Wells will be hosting training for the formula program. Ms. Wells reported that Ms. Joyce Hill will be conducting the training for completing an Analysis of Impediments and that other counties will be sending representatives to the training. The training will be held on May 9<sup>th</sup> in the Community Development Office.

Ms. Wells discussed the percentage the auditor's office will receive for the extra work performed regarding the grants. Ms. Wells stated that the auditor's office will be responsible for issuing checks and she added that she does not want to negotiate with that office every time a check arrives. Ms. Wells also added that a 1% fee across the board would not be fair to the auditor's office. It was then decided that Ms. Wells and Mr. Rick Shriver would meet with the auditor on Wednesday regarding the fees.

Mr. Stevan Hook, Engineer, reported that the county highway department would be trading in the 1998 Ford tractor for a Massey Ferguson tractor. Mr. Hook reported that a tractor with a cab is safer on the gravel roads while mowing than an open tractor. The total price after trade-in is \$14,995.00. Mr. Hook went on to say that the county highway department traded in a 1994 Ford tractor for an Alamo Versa mower with the total price after trade-in of \$8,005.00.

Mr. Hook also submitted sales orders for 2 additional mowers that the county highway department purchased. An Alamo VM60 was purchased for \$8,000.00 and an Alamo Versa was purchased for \$15,969.94.

Mr. Jeff Driggs, County Dog Warden, reported that a calf was killed by coyotes at Robert Leeper Jr.'s farm and that this is the third known calf killed this year by coyotes. Mr. Driggs also submitted his mileage report showing a total of 212.8 miles driven responding to dog calls. A total of 6 dogs was picked up one went missing from pound and 5 were destroyed.
