The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, July 17, 2006 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.  
The minutes of the July 10, 2006 meeting were read and approved.

The commissioners reported on their activities from the preceding week of July 10, 2006.

On Monday, The commissioners traveled to Caldwell to attend a Southeastern Ohio Solid Waste District Board of Directors meeting.

On Tuesday, Commissioner Moore attended an E.F.S.P. Board meeting at the Zanesville Salvation Army headquarters in Zanesville.

On Wednesday, Commissioners Moore and Shriver attended a Morgan County Community Improvement meeting and a MORGO Transit meeting in the Chamber room of the Riecker Complex. Commissioner Cain attended a Special Southeastern Ohio Regional Jail meeting in Nelsonville and Mr. Moore met with Larry Hivnor from the Ohio Valley Employment office, also on Wednesday, Commissioner Shriver met with Habitat for Humanity to discuss Real Estate.

On Thursday, Commissioners Cain and Shriver attended the testing of the Marcs Radio System at the airport, and met with Gary Williams at the Adult Learning Center, and later attended a college consortium meeting in the Riecker Complex. They held their community meeting in Pennsville Thursday evening.

On Friday, Commissioner Cain met with Judge Favreau concerning the roof on the courthouse.

The commissioners passed the following resolution to proclaim the 7<sup>th</sup> day of August as "Purple Heart Day."

***PROCLAMATION***  
***PURPLE HEART DAY***

**WHEREAS**, George Washington established the Purple Heart decoration During the Revolutionary War in 1782; and

**WHEREAS**, General Douglas MacArthur revised the Purple Heart decoration with George Orders Number 3 on February 22, 1932, commemorating the 200<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the birth of General Washington; and

**WHEREAS**, The Purple Heart Medal has been awarded to those military and naval officers receiving wounds in combat while defending our great nation;  
And

**WHEREAS**, the Purple Heart was the first decoration established for enlisted persons of the armed services and the first decoration for commissioned officers of the United States Army; and

**WHEREAS**, The Purple Heart is a symbol of American pride and patriotism and represents the sacrifices made by our dedicated armed services personnel in order to secure the freedoms and privileges that Americans enjoy every day;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THE MAYORS OF MALTA and McCONNELLSVILLE and the MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS do hereby proclaim the 7<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2006 as PURPLE HEART DAY, AND CALL THIS OBSERVANCE TO THE ATTENTION OF ALL CITIZENS.**

Mr. Jeff Shaner, OSU Extension Office, reported that the Farmers' Market had a great turn out Friday. He also stated that 4-H camp went well last week, even the rainy days, and stated all of the non-livestock 4-H judging will take place this week.

Mr. Shaner reported the Office on Aging has secured a sum of money for the seniors of Morgan County. Qualifying Morgan County Seniors will be able to sign up for coupons to purchase locally grown produce. All applicants must be 60 years old or older. The guidelines are: \$18,000 per year if single and \$24,000 per year if married.

Ms. Shannon Wells, Development Office, reported that her office had received a letter from Lieutenant Governor Bruce Johnson that Morgan County will receive a \$15,000 grant to assist with fair housing efforts in its communities. The funds will be awarded through the Ohio Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) New Horizons Fair Housing Assistance Program, administered by the Ohio Department of Development.

Ms. Wells reported that her next project will be the Transportation Project. It will be due September 1, 2006.

Mr. Steve Hook, Morgan County Engineer, reported that the bids for the paving of County Road 84, 2.3 miles of Crooksville to the Perry County line, will be due August 7, 2006. Engineer Hook's estimate was \$110,384.34.

Engineer Hook reported the bid opening for the design/build of a bridge, FEMA # 1580 "F" Bridge Repair, will be in the commissioners' office at 1:30 p.m. July 24, 2006.

Ms. Heather Lindsey, Xerox, stopped in to give quotes for a new copy machine for the Commissioners' office. Nothing was decided at that time.
