The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, July 31, 2006 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
The minutes of the July 24, 2006 meeting were read and approved.

The commissioners reported on their activities from the preceding week of July 24, 2006.

On Tuesday, Commissioner Moore attended the Area on Aging meeting at the Senior Center. Commissioner Cain met with Larry Hivnor concerning the Flood Control Grant for creek clean-up, and attended the Home Health Aid Training Graduation Ceremony. Tuesday night he attended the Planning Commission Meeting.

Wednesday, Commissioner Cain met with Rick Fox concerning the installation of a heating & air conditioning unit in the Sheriff's Office, and he met with Sheriff Jenkins concerning the floor tile installation and plumbing problems in the Sheriff's Office. Commissioner Cain later traveled to view the progress on the Adult Learning Center. Also on Wednesday, Commissioner Shriver met with Xerox Representatives to discuss copy equipment, and later Commissioner Shriver attended a meeting of the Morgan County Extravaganza with Shannon Wells to discuss a funding request for the Adult Learning Center.

On Thursday, Commissioner Cain traveled to Marietta to attend an ODOT meeting to discuss the 37-78 Road Project. The commissioners held their Community Meeting at the Kate-Love Simpson Library and later they attended the Morgan County School District's Bond Issue informational meeting at the Morgan High School. Commissioner Shriver traveled to Athens to meet with Representatives at the Voinovich Center.

On Friday, Commissioner Shriver met with Representatives of Predator LLC to resolve telecommunications issues.

Ms. Pam Montgomery, Family and Consumer Sciences Educator, OSU Extension Office, gave an update on the Family and Consumer Sciences and 4-H Youth Development at the OSU Extension Office in Morgan County. She reported that 4-H Camp was held July 10-14, 2006, at Camp Hervida. They had 67 campers, 9-13 years old and 13 camp counselors, 14 years old up to 19 years old.

Ms. Montgomery reported that the Cloverbud Day Camp will be August 2, 2006 at the Meigsville Community Center. There were 41 Cloverbuds (4-H members ages 5-8) registered. There will be 12 older youths serving as volunteers/counselors for the day.

Ms. Montgomery stated that 4-H Project Judging was held July 18 at the East Elementary School, and clothing judging and awards night was held July 20 at the Opera House. She reported that 46 youths were selected at the two judging days for the Ohio State Fair.

Mr. Chris Penrose and Ms. Pam Montgomery thanked all the Morgan County sites for showing their support to the Morgan County 4-H program by allowing use of their facilities for judging, awards Day and day camp.

As a Family and Consumer Sciences Educator, Pam Montgomery stated that she was offering Helping Children Cope with Divorce, sessions, a 2 hour seminar for parents with children under the age of 18 going through a divorce or dissolution. The program is offered 6 times annually. She has offered the program twice since she started last March. The next seminar is September 19, 2006 from 6:30-8:30 p.m. at the Riecker Complex in room 147.

Currently, she is working on getting the 4-H Canteen and Older Youth in Training programs started in the county as part of the 4-H program.

06-335 RESOLUTION

This agreement is hereby entered into on this 31st day of July 2006 between the Morgan County Board of MRDD (hereinafter referred to as MRDD) and the Morgan County Public Transportation (hereinafter referred to as MCPT).

1. MRDD agrees to lease the vehicles described below to MCPT for use in providing passenger transportation services.

WHEREAS, ensuring that children receive the financial support they deserve involves working partnerships between county, state and federal agencies, parents, legislators, judges, healthcare professionals, advocacy groups, employers and many others; and

WHEREAS, through these partnerships, Ohio collected over two billion dollars, leading the nation in dollars collected on current child support orders and ranking second in total collections distributed in 2005; and

WHEREAS, through the leadership of Morgan County Child Support Enforcement Agency, many children's lives are brighter because of the following accomplishments in the past year:

The collection of \$1,490,263.00 in current support collections and the collection of \$390,392.64 in child support arrearage collections during Federal Fiscal Year 2005 (October 1, 2004 to September 30, 2005).

WHEREAS, with the recognition of the above successes comes the acknowledgment that our children's lives count enough to pursue every possible effort to ensure that Ohio children receive the financial support they deserve.
