The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, November 13, 2006 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.  
The minutes of the November 6, 2006 meeting were read and approved.

**06-476** Motion by Mr. Dean Cain and seconded by Mr. Ron Moore to approve the minutes from November 6, 2006.

The commissioners reported on their activities from the preceding week of November 6, 2006.

On Monday, Commissioner Cain visited the Malta Complex facility to view the roof repairs.

On Tuesday, Commissioner Cain met with the Medical Response team at the Health Department.

On Wednesday, the Commissioners attended the Morgan County Community Improvement Corporation meeting in the Chamber room of the Riecker Complex. Later, Commissioners Cain and Moore met with Jim Baker from the Washington-Morgan Community Action Agency to discuss a homeowner rehab project that had been done several years ago. Commissioner Shriver met with Greg Ashby concerning the Transit line of credit. Later that day, Commissioner Cain visited with the Chesterhill Senior Citizens.

On Thursday, Commissioner Cain met with John Wells, McConnelsville Mayor and Mike Workman. He also attended the CIC special meeting and later that day attended the Issue 1, Round 21 meeting at Buckeye Hills.

Mr. Terry Spears, contractor submitted an Application to cross a public road. The applicant is the Morgan County Airport Authority, 770 Airport Rd, McConnelsville and has requested permission to bore under the Airport Road located in Meigsville, Twp, Morgan County. Said crossing is to be for 3 inch diameter Electric line (gas, oil, water, etc.) The construction of this project will begin on or about November 11, 2006 and will be completed by November 16, 2006. The commissioners approved the application.

Mr. Jim Ridenour, Department of Job and Family Services, submitted leave requests for himself, and submitted meeting requests for Marilyn Horner to Food Stamp Policy Training November 28<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup>, and 30<sup>th</sup> in Columbus. Mr. Ridenour recommended Crystal Moler for CSEA Account Clerk 2 position. All requests were approved. Mr. Ridenour submitted the Title XX County Profile for signatures. He also reported that an agency car hit a deer, and no employees were injured but the car did receive damage. He has spoken with the Insurance company concerning the automobile. Mr. Ridenour invited the commissioners to attend the Agency luncheon on Friday November 17<sup>th</sup>.

The duly elected Board of County Commissioners of Morgan County, Ohio met in regular session on the 13th day of November, 2006 at their office at 155 E. Main Street, McConnelsville, Ohio 43756 with the following members present, Rick Shriver, Dean Cain and Ron Moore and moves the adoption of the following resolution:

**WHEREAS**, the Morgan County Rural Transit, McConnelsville, Ohio requires operating capital during its startup,

**WHEREAS**, the Morgan County Rural Transit is seeking to apply for a line of credit for the operation of services for the residents of Morgan County,

**WHEREAS**, the funds from the line of credit will be used for the payment of invoices incurred by Morgan County Rural Transit and will be fully reimbursed from the Ohio Department of Transportation,

**Now Therefore Be It Resolved**, by the Board of the Morgan County Commissioners of Morgan County, State of Ohio, that the Morgan County Commissioners apply for a \$ 50,000.00 line of credit for the operation of the Morgan County Transit, and authorize Commissioner Rick Shriver to sign.

Commissioner Moore left the office at 1:05 PM to attend the Solid Waste meeting in Caldwell, Ohio.

Mr. Stevan Hook, Morgan County Engineer, submitted a Memorandum of Agreement for Ohio's Location Based Response System (LBRS) to the Commissioners for their signatures. The LBRS is conceived as a system of computers, hardware, software, communication networks, and data that creates an integrated, reliable street addressing solution with valid and verified address information. Mr. Hook discussed the various funding sources for the LBRS Program and discussed the LBRS 408 Grant funding application process. He also discussed mapping procedures.

Ms. Shannon Wells, Development Office, reported that all 4 local banks have responded to the request for the line of credit for the Morgan County Transit. Ms. Wells discussed the various rates and procedures for each bank. Ms. Wells reported that she will be attending a grant writing workshop in Columbus tomorrow and will meet on Wednesday with the Ohio Learning Network. She plans to meet with Mr. Terry McGrew, Administrator for the Health Department, later that day to discuss the Center for Higher Education's supply wish list. Ms. Wells reported that she will also discuss with Mr. Terry McGrew the possibility of getting a telephone line extension off of the Health Department's phone number for the Center for Higher Education. Mr. Rick Shriver, Commissioner, commented that a phone number is needed. Over 30 people attended the meeting for the Nursing program recently. Ms. Wells reported that she is ready to place the order with Staples for the Center for Higher Education classroom furniture; she reported that Bragg's has ordered some of the lounge furniture. Ms. Wells has spoken with Mr. Duane King concerning the countertop installation at the Center for Higher Education. He is planning on stopping by the Center for Higher Education to see if he would be able to install the countertops. Ms. Wells also reported that she had received a call back from AEP concerning a donation for the Center for Higher Education. AEP has a program where they donate recycled computers to Education centers. Ms. Wells reported that this might be a possibility and will get more information and report back to the Commissioners. Ms. Wells met with Peoples Transportation today concerning the managed care providers network. Ms. Wells reported that Peoples Transportation has a managed care transportation service set up in several Ohio counties, but has no plans to set up an office in Morgan County. Peoples Transportation discussed that 2600 people in Morgan County are eligible for Medicaid transportation and letters are being sent to let them know about this. Peoples transportation has submitted a contract to Morgan County Transit for review, and Peoples would contract with Morgan County Transit for the Medicaid transportation services in Morgan County. Ms. Wells also inquired about snow removal at the Center for Higher Education/Health Center/Dr. Murrel's office. The Commissioners discussed with Ms. Wells the submission of timesheets to the Auditor's office. Ms. Wells also reported that she was contacted by the Ohio Historic Preservation office requesting additional photos of the Stockport Gym. Ms. Wells requested a meeting with Commissioner Rick Shriver and Gary Woodward, Auditor, to go over the financial reports for her office.
