

**MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, November 6, 2006 with the following members present:

Dean Cain, Vice-President

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
The minutes of the October 30, 2006 meeting were read and approved.

The commissioners reported on their activities from the preceding week of October 30, 2006.

On Tuesday, Commissioner Moore traveled to Marietta for a Buckeye Hills-Hocking Valley Development District General Policy Board meeting. Commissioner Cain attended a Planning Commission meeting.

On Wednesday, Commissioner Shriver attended the Technology Exposition at the Shrine Auditorium in Columbus. Commissioner Cain met with DLZ Engineering Company and attended the Health Fair in Chesterhill.

On Thursday, Commissioner Cain met with John Wells and Mike Workman concerning economic development.

On Friday, Commissioners Shriver and Moore participated in the Guest Reader program by reading to students at West Elementary. That evening Commissioner Shriver attended a ribbon cutting and re-dedication of turbines at the Stockport Mill.

Ms. Mary Gessel, Clerk of Courts, reported that the Title Budget is at a \$22,000 deficit. Ms. Gessel reported that she is not expecting any large revenues in the future to help cover the expenses for the Title office. She requested guidance from the Commissioners as to how to handle this issue, either the department needs to be funded or she needs to be ordered to close it. Ms. Gessel reported that automobiles being titled out of the county have had an impact on the revenue for the department. She reported that automobiles purchased out of the county can be titled in Morgan County and people purchasing automobiles can request this at the auto dealership. Ms. Gessel reported that within the last two weeks there have been 2 class action lawsuits filed, with 68 defendants. She reported that the envelopes, postage and mailers have created an expense to the county, this will be reimbursed by the Attorney's at the end of the cases. Ms. Gessel reported that she has used all of 2006 and 2007 supply of certified mailings due to the two class action lawsuits. Ms. Gessel also reported that she is having issues with the internet and email service.

Mr. Jeff Shaner, OSU Extension, reported that CIC will meet on Wednesday at 8 am. Mr. Shaner reported that the Senior Nutrition Program has been completed with the close of the Farmer's Market. The program has been well received with the Area Agency on Aging receiving 331 coupons in August, with a 94 % turn

in rate. Total amount from Coupons redeemed was \$5110.00. They are looking at doing the program again in the future. The Farmer's Market will be holding an evaluation meeting on November 20 and Potluck with the vendor's. For 2006 there were 49 vendors as compared to 52 for 2005 and 14 vendors on average per week in 2006 compared to 12 for 2005. Chris Penrose, Extension Educator will be holding Master Gardner training next week. He is also planning the Small Farm College with 8 other counties. Mr. Shaner also discussed a regional development effort.

Mr. Jim Ridenour, Department of Job and Family Services, submitted meeting requests for the following people: Tina Work and Jenna Hopkins to SCOTI LE Workshop on November 7th & 8th in Columbus; Cheryl Bailey to Core Module VI Training on November 15th, 16th, and 17th in Athens; Steve Kinney, Angela Westfall and Ginger Bowen to Quarterly Fraud Control meeting on December 12th in Athens. Mr. Ridenour submitted supply requests for miscellaneous office supplies totaling \$225.27 and for a Digital Camera for Children Services totaling \$149.98. The requests were approved. Mr. Ridenour reported that the Agency Thanksgiving Luncheon will be held on November 17th from 12:00 - 1:00 pm. He also reported that Job Interviews for CSEA will be held Wednesday and Thursday. Mr. Ridenour reported that water is leaking from upstairs in room 010.

The Commissioners are in receipt of the TANF Two-Parent Ohio Works First Non-Assistance Allocation for October 1, 2006 through June 30, 2008.

The Commissioners are in receipt of a letter regarding OH-14 NEG Disaster Flood Grant and the DOL Press Release regarding additional funding.

Ms. Shannon Wells, Development Office, reported that the Family and Children First Council meeting minutes for September and October are being submitted for the Commissioners signatures. Ms. Wells reported that Commissioner Shriver and she will be meeting with Mr. Kyle Newton, Administrative Assistant Morgan Local Schools and Mr. Tom Heppner, Computer Technology Coordinator Morgan Local Schools concerning the possibility for the Adult Learning Center to tap into the School Systems line for high speed internet connectivity. Ms. Wells reported that Mr. Terry McGrew, Administrator Morgan County Health Department had contacted her last week and offered to help the Adult Learning Center with donations of office supplies. She also reported that the countertops for the Adult Learning Center are finished and ready for pick-up. Ms. Wells discussed the various quotes she has obtained from local businesses for the lounge furniture and the quotes for the classroom furniture. Ms. Wells reported that based on the lowest quotes she recommended Staples for the purchase of the classroom furniture and Bragg's Furniture for the lounge furniture. Ms. Wells reported on the line of credit for Transit. She reported that she is still waiting to hear back from several banks on the rates and procedures for securing this line of

credit. Ms. Wells reported that they need to get the line of credit set up so that the bills can be paid. Ms. Wells also discussed with the Commissioners her obtaining a county credit card.

The Commissioners signed the Morgan County Family and Children First Council grant request supporting the requested \$40,000 per county for the Family and Children First Administrative Grant in the next State Budget.

Ms. Linda Sheets, Area Office on Aging reported that Embarq keeps billing their office a late charge, Mr. Moore advised Ms. Sheets to contact Embarq and discuss with them that government entities are not charged late fees. Ms. Sheets reported that the Area Office on Aging was awarded a \$1000.00 Grant from Sam's Club in Zanesville. She stated that this can be a yearly grant if her office applies for it. Ms. Sheets requested permission to obtain a Sam's Club card and be able to purchase some supplies from Sam's Club. Her request was approved.

Mr. Stevan Hook, Morgan County Engineer, reported that at 10 am on Thursday at the Holiday Inn in Marietta a meeting by the Integrating Committee will be held to review points for Issue 2 money. Mr. Hook reported that this is open to the General Public and Project leaders can attend to plead their cases for their respective projects. Mr. Hook reported that he had received a phone call from Mr. Dave Blackstone, ODOT and they are willing to help with \$13,000 for the centerline mapping. He has spoken to several other organizations but has yet to hear back from them. Mr. Hook reported that a letter of Commitment will need to be prepared to proceed with the mapping for Morgan County. Mr. Hook reported that the Motor Paving for Parmiter Road has begun, the motor paving for McConnelsville will begin tomorrow weather permitting and the piling job on Townhouse hill has be started. Mr. Hook reported that the findings for the Audit on the FEMA projects have been reviewed.
