Ms. Shannon Wells, Development Office, reported that she met with Ken Reed, Vinton County Development Office, on Friday to see how they handle the payment of grant monies into their office. Ms. Wells requested information on the time frame she has on spending the grant money. Ms. Wells submitted the final payment for Silverheels Construction to the Commissioners for approval. This was for work on the Morgan County Center for Higher Education. Ms. Wells discussed the ARC Grant and the Extravaganza monies and that part of those monies has been earmarked for Computers and equipment for the Adult Learning Center. She also discussed the upcoming Consortium of Higher Education meeting later this month and that details for the lease will need to be worked out. Ms. Wells reported that she has completed a press release on the Continuum of Care meeting. She reported that she is working on environmental reviews and will be meeting with Rob Gunter from RFG concerning grants. Ms. Wells reported that she had received a phone call from Corrine White requesting her to speak on a video, but will be declining that offer. Ms. Wells also met with Melissa Zoller, Buckeye Hills, concerning the application process for Phase 2 money for the Longaberger facility.
