The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Tuesday, October 9, 2007 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. The minutes of the October 1, 2007 meeting were read and approved.

On Friday, Commissioner Shriver traveled to Dayton to observe how Montgomery County Commissioners dispose of surplus items via the Internet.

On Saturday, Commissioner Shriver attended the Hickory Ridge Festival.

Jeff Shaner, OSU Extension Office, updated Commissioners on Extension Office activities.

Commissioners granted permission for Knox Energy, Inc. to bore under County Road 75, located in York Township, Section 24, Morgan County, Ohio for a 2 inch diameter gas line. Construction of this project will begin on or about October 9th, 2007.

Commissioners granted permission for Gerald Clutter to bore under County Road 84, located in York Township, Section 24, Morgan County, Ohio for a gas line. Construction of this project will begin on or about October 10th, 2007.

Commissioners are in receipt of a letter requesting the release of marriage license fees and divorce/dissolution fees that are due for the Third Quarter of 2007, as submitted by Barbara Davis, Executive Director, Transitions, Inc.

Commissioners signed the Lease Agreement for use of the kitchen and dining area at the Riecker Building by the Senior Nutrition program, submitted by Carrie McNamee, Director, Washington-Morgan County Community Action Program Corporation.

Commissioners granted permission for Steve Hook, Engineer, to purchase a 2007 GMC 2500 HD pickup truck from WMD Motors, Inc. as long as it is under \$25,000.00.
