The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, December 10, 2007 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.  
The minutes of the December 3, 2007 meeting were read and approved.

Commissioner Dean Cain and Commissioner Rick Shriver left the Commissioner's meeting at 1 p.m. to attend the Solid Waste meeting in Caldwell. The Commissioners returned to the office at 4:00 p.m.

Commissioners reported on their activities for the week December 3, 2007.

On Sunday, Commissioner Shriver and Commissioner Reynolds attended the Christmas Tree Sale for Habitat for Humanity.

On Monday, Commissioner Reynolds and Commissioner Cain attended House Bill 9 Training at Washington State Community College.

On Monday, Commissioner Shriver met with John Rauch from Rural Community Assistance Program.

On Tuesday, Commissioner Cain met with Brandon Kern from Senator Voinovich Office.

On Tuesday, Commissioner Shriver attended a seminar on "Selling to the Government," Sponsored by Congressman Zack Space.

On Thursday, Commissioner Shriver participated in a telephone press conference with Congressman Space, Wade Benjamin, owner of ABC Manufacturing, and members of the media.

On Thursday, Commissioner Shriver also met with a group of citizens to hear concerns about issues affecting public agencies.

Commissioners are in receipt of November Interest Earned, reported by Rebecca Foster, Treasurer.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services, submitted meeting requests for Jan Snouffer to "Handling Irate Clients" on December 11 in Athens, Candi Drake to "CRISE Sanctions" on March 26 and 27 in Zanesville. Ms. Quesinberry submitted a revised On the Job Training Agreement regarding ABC Manufacturing for the Commissioners' approval.

The Morgan Local School District will be making the final payment of the lease/purchase of the building located at 65 W. Union Ave by the end of December, according to Gary Woodward, Auditor.

The Commissioners received a request from Acting Prosecutor Amy Graham to appoint a special counsel to represent Morgan County in a challenge to the candidacy of Mr. Rick Welch for Morgan County Prosecutor.

Padden be appointed in the capacity of Special Prosecutor in the prosecution of an action in which the Prosecuting Attorney's Office has a conflict of interest and for the purpose of avoiding event the appearance of impropriety. The Special Prosecutor will be paid at the rate of \$85.00 per hour.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development office, discussed the lease termination agreement between the Commissioners and Primecare. Mrs. Wells also discussed the lease agreement with Muskingum Valley Health Center starting January 1, 2008. Effective January 1, 2008, Dr. Barbara Murrell will change her affiliation from Primecare to Muskingum Valley Health Centers, necessitating a change in the lease.

The 2008 contract was signed between Ohio Department of Transportation and Morgan County Rural Transit. Morgan County Rural Transit has just received a 2008 Ford Light Transit Narrow Body Van, seating capacity of 12, into its fleet.

A Public Hearing was held at 10:00 AM on the request to continue the temporary closure of the south portion of Morgan County Road 11. Commissioners heard comments from representatives of Consolidated Coal, a representative of the Meigsville Township Trustees, and from members of the public concerning extending the temporary closure. "Consol" has requested that temporary closure be extended until the end of 2009 to allow the safe completion of reclamation activities at the former site of the "Prep Plant." Consol representatives express concerns for public safety if the road is re-opened before reclamation work is complete. They cited several instances of trespassing and vandalism that have already jeopardized public safety. Some members of the public expressed their concerns that Consol has not acted in good faith regarding the closure. Their concerns centered on the lack of any efforts to date to restore the road, which has been closed for approximately 20 years.

Commissioners are receipt of a letter submitted by David Hooper, President, UMWA Local 1604, in support of extending the temporary closure of County Road 11.

The Commissioners advised the group that after due consideration and consultation with Morgan County Engineer, Stevan Hook, they will render a decision before the end of 2007. Consolidated Coal will be notified in writing of the Commissioners' decision.
