

**MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
RIECKER BUILDING**

The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, December 17, 2007 with the following members present:

Dean Cain, Vice-President
Don Reynolds, Member

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. The minutes of the December 10, 2007 meeting were read and approved.

07-1100 Motion by Mr. Dean Cain and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from December 10, 2007.

Commissioners reported on their activities for the week December 10, 2007.

On Monday, Commissioner Cain and Commissioner Shriver attended the Joint Solid Waste meeting in Caldwell, Ohio.

On Tuesday, Commissioner Cain and his wife attended the senior lunch in the Reicker Building.

On Tuesday, Commissioner Cain attended a meeting of the Revolving Loan Committee.

On Thursday, Commissioner Shriver spoke to the members of the Morgan County Public Employees Retirement International.

On Friday, Commissioner Cain and Commissioner Shriver attended the Council of Governments meeting, along with Director of Job and Family Services Vicki Quesinberry and Workforce Development Director, Kim Reed. The meeting was held in Caldwell, Ohio.

Chris Penrose, OSU Extension, discussed upcoming events. OSU Extension will be holding interviews for Jr. Fair Board on December 17, 2007, and the recertification for private pesticide applicators will be held on January 17, 2008. The deadline for market steer projects is on January 4, 2008. Market steer exhibitors should call the OSU Extension Office for details. 4-H will be sponsoring a square dance on December 31, 2007 at the Stockport Community Center.

Director of the Regional Solid Waste District, Robert Reiter, called and discussed a grant for which he will be applying. The funds will be used for the clean-up along the Muskingum River Parkway. Reiter discussed four locations in Morgan County where large roll-off dumpsters would be temporarily placed to dispose of refuse collected along the riverbanks.

Glen Dawson attended the meeting to indicate he wishes to be considered for re-appointment to the Morgan County Airport Authority.

Morgan County Commissioners are in receipt of a letter submitted by Della Bratton. Ms. Bratton would like the county to report monthly on the funds that are coming into the county starting in the upcoming year.

Morgan County Commissioners are in receipt of a letter submitted by Jack Bonsell. Mr. Bonsell is resigning from his Commissioner-appointed position on the Muskingum River Advisory Council. The Commissioners are seeking a replacement for Mr. Bonsell. Interested residents of Morgan County should contact the Commissioners' office to indicate their interest in serving on the Muskingum River Advisory Council.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, discussed the transit office hours. Starting in January, the transit office will have extended hours to better serve transit clients. Mrs. Wells also announced that Ray and Ila Wright won the \$25.00 gift certificate for filling out the Village of McConnelsville survey. This survey will help with applying for a grant this spring.

Mrs. Wells also recommended that transit employees be recognized for the system's excellent safety record by rewarding employees. Mrs. Wells advised the Commissioners that Ohio Department of Transportation has give approval for the employees to receive small tokens of appreciation for their work and safety record. All expenses associated with the operation of Morgan County Rural Transit are reimbursed by ODOT.

Mrs. Wells and the Commissioners discussed the line of credit which the transit uses to pay operating expenses while awaiting reimbursement from ODOT. While all expenses are completely reimbursed, the reimbursement process sometimes takes several weeks. The line of credit provides necessary operating funds.

Morgan County Commissioners will enter into a new lease agreement with Muskingum Valley Health Center on January 1, 2008. Muskingum Valley Health Centers will operate Morgan County Family Health, with Dr. Barbra Murrell as primary physician in the Morgan County Health Center. Therefore it is necessary to terminate the current lease agreement with Primecare.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Service, submitted meeting requests for Kim Reed to “Scoti Report” on December 17 in Caldwell. Morgan County Commissioners’ are in receipt of the On Job Training Contract Agreement with ABC Manufacturing. Ms. Quesinberry also discussed the contract with Maximus for annual PET Maintenance Agreement from January 1, 2008 to December 31, 2008 in the amount of \$2,100.00. The PET system allows DJFS to track expenditures.

The Commissioners discussed the 2008 General Fund Budget at length and worked on setting 2007 appropriations. The Commissioners expressed grave concern over revenue shortfalls projected again for 2008. Sales tax receipts continued to decline in 2007. The General Fund is also negatively impacted by the new business tax structure in the state of Ohio. While the new Commercial Activity Tax has been valuable in attracting new industry and encouraging expansions in Ohio, including Morgan County, it will generate less revenue for the counties.

The General Fund receives only a small portion of the revenue generated from real estate property tax. Most of that revenue is directed to schools, MRDD, fire and ambulance services, and other designated recipients and services.

In light of increasing expenditures for health insurance and other mandated spending, the budget is again in a dire situation. Receipts are projected to be nearly \$200,000 below the amount required to fund offices at the same level as 2007. The Commissioners projected that even if they were to fund to offices at the same level as last year, the offices will have shortfalls resulting from state-mandated increases in the stipends of the office-holders.

The Commissioners will again send a memo to all office holders and department heads urging them to prepare for a very lean year. The memo will suggest that it is fiscally irresponsible to increase employee salaries and other spending in light of the present budget crisis. Deficit spending violates state law.

The Commissioners also discussed increasing the real estate transfer fee (“conveyance fee”) to help offset the shortfall. Morgan County is one of only half dozen counties that still have their transfer fees set at \$1.00 per thousand. The others at that level are generally larger counties that handle many more transfers annually. Those counties generate more revenue due to the volume of transfers.

Increasing the conveyance fee to \$3.00 per thousand could generate an additional \$40,000, based on the transfers recorded in 2007. Revenue generated from the fees would go to the General Fund and could be designated to help fund the Recorder, Auditor, and Treasurer offices, where most of the real estate transfer activity occurs.

The conveyance fee is based on the sale price of real estate. The Commissioners discussed an example of a \$100,000 real estate sale, which would require a \$300 transfer fee, if the increase is approved. Presently that sale would yield a \$100 fee to General Fund.

No action was taken on the conveyance fee. The Commissioners agreed to continue to study the impact of the fee, with action likely to be taken in early 2008.

07-1113 Motion by Mr. Rick Shriver and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the proposal to extend the temporary closure of Morgan County Road 11 South for an additional two years through December 31, 2009, based on the assurance that CONSOL will begin the rehabilitation of the road in 2008. Morgan County Commissioners' are in receipt of a letter from CONSOL ENERGY in regards to keeping County Road 11 closed. In their proposal "Central Ohio Coal Company's intention is to begin rehabilitation work on CR 11 south in the 2008 calendar year and we're fully committed to completing the process by December 31, 2009. Throughout the rehabilitation process of Morgan County Road 11 South, Central Ohio Coal Company will be in communication with Morgan County in a good-faith effort to facilitate successful completion of the project should any obstacles be encountered."

Commissioners are in receipt of a letter of support for the closure from the UMW Local President, David Hooper.

Commissioners also sought the input of Morgan County Engineer, Stevan Hook, who expressed concerns for public safety and liability for the county if the road is re-opened before the reclamation work is complete at the former "prep plant."

After discussion, Commissioner Shriver re-stated that his motion was to approve the extension of the temporary closure, and is predicated on the assurance of CONSOL that work on the road's rehabilitation will begin in 2008.
