The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, August 13, 2007 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. The minutes of the August 6, 2007 meeting were read and approved.

**07-918** Motion by Mr. Dean Cain and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from August 6, 2007.

Commissioners reported on their activities for the week August 6, 2007.

Commissioners Rick Shriver and Dean Cain met with Jeff Shaner, Mike Workman, and two perspective business owners, on August 8<sup>th</sup>.

Commissioners Rick Shriver, Dean Cain, and Don Reynolds attended the Morgan County Community Improvement Corporation meeting, on August 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>.

Commissioner Don Reynolds attended the Area Agency on Aging meeting on August 10<sup>th</sup>.

Commissioner Dean Cain met with a local business owner concerning expansion on August 6<sup>th</sup> and August 10<sup>th</sup>. Commissioner Cain met with Jeff Shaner, Mike Workman, and a perspective business owner, on August 7<sup>th</sup>.

Commissioners Rick Shriver, Dean Cain and Don Reynolds attended the Bristol Township meeting, on August 9<sup>th</sup>.

Commissioners Rick Shriver, Dean Cain and Don Reynolds traveled to meet with Gary Miller and Tom Schott, Central Ohio Coal Co., to view County Road 11 South, on August 13<sup>th</sup>.

Tim Smedley discussed the Dog Warden, Jeff Driggs, refusing to pick up his daughter's dog after it bit his granddaughter. Mr. Smedley noted the dog didn't have tags nor was it current on shots. Mr. Smedley noted Mike Totman picked up the dog and took it to the vet. Commissioner Dean Cain agreed with Mr. Smedley that the dog needed to be impounded for 10 days. Commissioners said they would speak with Mr. Driggs.

Commissioners spoke with Jeff Driggs, Dog Warden, concerning a dog bite. Mr. Driggs explained that several dogs have died from a possible case of parvo within the dog pound. Mr. Driggs believed it would be risky impounding the dog at the dog pound. The little girl would have to endure rabies shots if the dog didn't survive the 10 days. Mr. Driggs didn't want that to happen. Mr. Driggs also said he didn't feel the county should have to pay for the dog since it wasn't a stray.

Jeff Shaner, OSU Extension Office, updated Commissioners on the Extension Office activities for the week.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services, submitted meeting requests for Jody Murray to PCSAO Annual Conference in Columbus, on September 26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup>; Reuben Kittle to PCSAO Annual Conference in Columbus, on September 26<sup>th</sup>. Ms. Quesinberry submitted the revised SFY 2008 Final County Share of Reimbursable Income Maintenance-Human Services Expenditures State Fiscal Year 2008.

Commissioners signed the School Readiness Enrichment and After-school Program contract between the Morgan County Department of Job and Family Services and Morgan Local Schools, as submitted by Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, discussed establishing a Local Revolving Loan Fund. Mrs. Wells noted it would be a great asset to the county and the interest earned could be used as a match for other grants. Mrs. Wells discussed purchasing equipment for the Learning Center.

John Sampson, Morgan County Rural Transit, discussed contracting with the Imagination Station to transport children to East Elementary.

Brenda James and John Miller, James Insurance, discussed the opportunity to receive a County Risk Sharing Authority (CORSA) program proposal. CORSA is endorsed by the County Commissioners Association of Ohio. Commissioner Shriver noted the county would be interested in receiving a quote.

Commissioners granted permission for American Electric Power to span over County Road 36, located in Windsor Township, Section 50-51, Morgan County, for an electric line. Construction of this project will begin on or about September, October, or November 2007 and will be completed by December, 2007.

Commissioners granted permission for Logan Energy, Inc. to bore under County Road 59, located in Marion Township, Section 13, Morgan County, for a 1.5 inch gas line. Construction of this project will begin on or about August 15, 2007 and will be completed by August 18, 2007.

Commissioners granted permission to Sons of the American Legion Little League Football to use the Commons to practice football, as requested by Bobby White.

Commissioners are in receipt of a letter submitted by Tim Bish, Superintendent, MRDD, concerning Bob Drabik resigning from the MRDD Board.

**DECLARING THE AMOUNT OF TAXES THAT MAY BE RAISED BY LEVY AT THE MAXIMUM RATE AUTHORIZED BY LAW WITHOUT A VOTE OF ELECTORS TO BE INSUFFICIENT AND DECLARING THE NECESSITY TO A LEVY IN EXCESS OF SUCH RATE.**

Be it resolved by the Morgan County Board of Commissioners, Morgan County, Ohio all members elected thereto concurring:

**SECTION I.** That the amount of taxes that may be raised by the levy of taxes at the minimum rate authorized by O.R.C. 5705.19 on the taxable property in said County will be insufficient to provide adequate amount of necessary requirements of said County, and it is necessary for the purpose of providing additional funds for ambulance service for Morgan County for a period of five years at a rate in excess of the maximum rate authorized by O.R.C. 5705.19.

**SECTION II.** That it will be necessary to pass the levy for taxes for tax years 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011, being a renewal of tax of 1.60 mills on each dollar of tax valuation for five (5) years (which amounts to sixteen (16) cents for each One Hundred Dollars (\$100 of valuation), of the taxable property within Morgan County in excess of the rate authorized by O.R.C. 5705.19.

**SECTION III.** Be it further resolved that said levy be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next preceding the election, if a majority of electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

**SECTION IV.** That the clerk be and is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Morgan County Board of Elections in order that the said board of Elections may make the

necessary arrangements of submission of such questions to the electors of Morgan County at the General Election on November 6, 2007.
