

**MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
RIECKER BUILDING**

The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, August 6, 2007 with the following members present:

Rick Shriver, President  
Dean Cain, Vice-President  
Don Reynolds, Member

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.  
The minutes of the July 30, 2007 meeting were read and approved.

**07-906** Motion by Mr. Dean Cain and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from July 30, 2007.

Commissioners reported on their activities for the week July 30, 2007.

Commissioners Rick Shriver, Dean Cain, and Don Reynolds attended a meeting with Bob Smiddy to discuss healthcare for all of Ohio, on August 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Commissioner Dean Cain met with John Lanning, RHS Solutions, and Tim Bish, MRDD, to discuss Worker's Compensation on August 3<sup>rd</sup>. Mr. Cain also attended a Buckeye Hills Hocking Valley meeting in Marietta.

Commissioner Don Reynolds attended the Planning Commission meeting on July 31<sup>st</sup> and the PRC meeting with the Department of Job and Family Services, on August 1<sup>st</sup>.

Commissioner Rick Shriver met with two principals of a potential new business in Morgan County, on August 1<sup>st</sup>.

Commissioners granted permission for Don Eckert to bore under County Road 60, located in Windsor Township, Section 2, Morgan County, Ohio, for a 1 inch water line. Construction of this project will begin on or about August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2007 and will be completed by September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2007.

Commissioners are in receipt of a statement concerning the Morgan County Jail usage for July 2007. A total of 139 prisoners were kept in the Morgan County Jail to lower costs at the Southeastern Ohio Regional Joint Jail. This count is prisoners held here for at least one day each and other prisoners were also brought for court and returned, which are in addition to these figures.

Commissioners signed the request for Sub-ordination of Mortgage for Mary Robertson.

Commissioners are in receipt of a letter from Cheryl Hanson, Employment Specialist, Washington-Morgan Community Action thanking the Commissioners for their contribution to the 2007 Summer Youth Program.

The Southeastern Ohio Joint Solid Waste Management District will have a Computer-TV-Electronics Collection on August 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>, at Mary Hammond, 900 S. Riverside Drive.

Commissioners are in receipt of a letter submitted by John Lepi, M.D., concerning dropping out of the Medical Mutual network, as of August 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2007.

Commissioners granted permission to raise Traci Kidd, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, hourly rate from \$8.50 to \$10.00, as recommended by Shannon Wells, Director, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office.

Heidi Burns, Department of Job and Family Services, submitted a travel request for Steve Kinney, Angie Westfall and Ginger Bowen to Annual Investigator Training in Worthington, Ohio on September 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>. Ms. Burns submitted copies of the Department of Job and Family Services Personnel Policies and Procedures effective August 8, 2007, and the SFY 2008-2009 State Biennial Budget Summary- Final HB 119, as signed by the Governor.

Commissioners signed the Morgan County Prevention, Retention, and Contingency (PRC) Plan. The PRC changes are effective August 6<sup>th</sup>, 2007. The eligibility for some programs was increased to 200% of the Federal Poverty level. Prevention/Retention Service changes include increasing amount for once in a lifetime auto purchase amount to actual need up to \$5000 (provided through local auto dealerships-not a relative). The purchase of a sport utility vehicle or a pickup truck is not allowed. One must agree not to sell the vehicle for 12 months and must earn at least \$200 per week. There is no repayment on an auto purchase. Families at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level are eligible for \$200 per child for school supplies and clothes. Only local providers can be used such as: Family Dollar, Dollar General, Shriver's Pharmacy, and the Jesus Loves You Thrift Shop.

Jeff Shaner, OSU Extension Office, updated Commissioners on the Extension Office activities for the week.

Linda Sheets, Senior Citizen's Center, informed Commissioners the United Way "Step Into Shoes" will be held at the Methodist Church, on August 8<sup>th</sup>. Mrs. Sheets noted her office will be taking seniors to the Wild's on August 10<sup>th</sup> and to the Muskingum County Fair for Senior Citizen's Day, on August 14<sup>th</sup>. The Area Agency on Aging Council meeting will be on August 10<sup>th</sup>.

John Sampson, Morgan County Public Transit, discussed working with South East Area Transit for transportation services to Zanesville. Mr. Sampson noted the Ohio Department of Transportation supports and encourages this. South East Area Transit will be working with Morgan County Public Transit on a trial basis right now. Commissioners support John Sampson's efforts and believe this is a good idea.

Shannon Wells and Traci Kidd, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, discussed the air conditioning not working in Dr. Murrell's office. Commissioners recommended they contact local contractors. Mrs. Wells followed up on the Safe Harbor Resources meeting. Commissioner Rick Shriver noted he will be contacting Larry Hivnor and Glenn Enslin. Mrs. Wells noted her office is moving along in preparation for the Morgan County Fair. The Development Office has received quotes for blinds at the Morgan County Learning Center.

Dorothy Shriver inquired where the cleaning supplies were bought for the Riecker building. Mrs. Shriver noted the building had an undesirable odor when she entered the building.

Rita Bankes, Corrections and Probations Officer, inquired about getting a restroom in the Morgan County Jail fixed.

Della Bratton telephoned Commissioners to discuss the Board of Elections. Ms. Bratton is uncomfortable with the upcoming election and feels the Board of Elections needs to be audited. Commissioner Rick Shriver informed Ms. Bratton she's entitled to an honest election and he felt the electoral process was not compromised. Ms. Bratton inquired who places members on the board. Commissioner Dean Cain informed Ms. Bratton the Central Committees places members to the Board of Elections, two members each are appointed per political party.
