The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Tuesday, February 20, 2007 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. The minutes of the February 12, 2007 meeting were read and approved.

Commissioners reported on their activities for the week February 12, 2007.

Commissioners Don Reynolds and Dean Cain met with John Lanning, RHS Solutions, and Steve Hook, Engineer, Friday February 16, 2007.

Commissioner Dean Cain met with a business owner in New Philadelphia concerning a business possibility in Morgan County.

Chris Penrose, O.S.U. Extension Office, noted the Grazing Council Kick-Off will be 7pm March 5, 2007 at the Community Building in Reinersville. Managing and Marketing Woodlands meeting will be April 3, 2007. 4-H week will be March 4-10, 2007 and the 4-H Kick-Off will be March 17, 2007 (Quality Assurance for Youth and Advisory Training). Pesticide Training to obtain a new private license will be 7pm March 12, 2007 at the Morgan County High School. Pesticide testing for commercial and private operators will be March 27, 2007. Morgan, Muskingum, and Perry Counties will be providing training for New Commercial Pesticide Operator Licenses March 26, 2007 in Zanesville. Mr. Penrose noted State Law requires anyone applying pesticides in/around any public property must be licensed.
