The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, February 26, 2007 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. The minutes of the February 20, 2007 meeting were read and approved.

Commissioners reported on their activities for the week February 20, 2007.

Commissioner Dean Cain met with CZF Engineering and the Ohio Department of Transportation for an update on the Feasibility Study for the Bridge Crossing on February 22, 2007.

Commissioners Don Reynolds and Dean Cain met with Marlys Barbee, representing the Coalition of Concerned Citizens, discussed concerns with the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District on February 23, 2007.

Commissioners Rick Shriver and Dean Cain attended the Morgan County Community Improvement Corporation meeting on February 21, 2007.

Jim Ridenour, Department of Job and Family Services, submitted a leave request for himself and meeting requests for Cheryl Bailey and Kari Krause to Domestic Violence Training March 6 and 7, in Athens.

Shannon Wells and Traci Kidd, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, held a Community Development Block Grant Public Hearing. Mrs. Wells provided an overview of CDBG

programs, the CDBG National Objectives, who is eligible to apply for formula funding, what activities are eligible, and how to submit an application. Mrs. Wells also discussed the Community Distress Program.

Della Bratton telephoned the Commissioners, to alert taxpayers that they have until March 31, 2007 to file an appeal on real estate taxes. Commissioners noted the appeal is against the valuation of real property not the amount of real estate taxes being charged. Anyone interested in filing an appeal should contact the Auditor's Office. Ms. Bratton felt that it was important for all taxpayers to understand this right.

Commissioners Rick Shriver, Dean Cain, and Don Reynolds attended a Local Emergency Planning Committee meeting at noon Monday, February 26, and later met with Judge Lowe to discuss operation and funding of the County Court.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, reviewed expenses and revenues for Transit and discussed the proposed Transit budget for 2007.

Linda Sheets, Office on Aging, presented the Title III-D Disease Prevention and Health Promotion Contract to be signed by commissioners.

Jeanne Wilson, representing Senator Sherrod Brown's Office, inquired what issues are facing Morgan County. Commissioners noted to Ms. Wilson that infrastructure, such as the availability of public water and sewer, is critical for the county's economic development, and retraining/reeducating our workforce are some of the major concerns for the county. The Commissioners also mentioned Veterans' Services, Unfunded Government Mandates, and Highway Funding.
