The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, June 18, 2007 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.  
The minutes of the June 11, 2007 meeting were read and approved.

Commissioners reported on their activities for the week June 11, 2007.

Commissioners Rick Shriver, Dean Cain and Don Reynolds attended the Morgan County Community Improvement Corporation meeting and the Manchester Township meeting, on June 14<sup>th</sup>. On June 15<sup>th</sup>, Commissioners Rick Shriver, Dean Cain and Don Reynolds attended the Relay for Life.

Commissioners Don Reynolds and Rick Shriver attended the Morgan County Public Auction, on June 16<sup>th</sup>.

Commissioner Rick Shriver attended the Historical Society meeting on June 11<sup>th</sup>, the Muskingum County Health Center Board of Directors meeting, on June 12<sup>th</sup>, and the Chamber of Commerce Fund Raising Committee meeting, on June 13<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Shriver and the Board of Revisions traveled and viewed property on which owners are seeking an adjustment in values, on June 15<sup>th</sup>.

Commissioners signed the contracts for ceiling repairs at Rock Hollow Schools and gymnasium floors for the Stockport Community Center.

Commissioners signed an agreement for Lock One Engineering to commence core drilling on three bridges, as submitted by Steve Hook, Engineer.

Steve Hook, Engineer, discussed the contract with Ohio Bridge requesting payment for an additional 40 yards of concrete. Mr. Hook noted this was a billing error and there is no additional cost to the county. Mr. Hook noted a bid opening for Round 21, Ohio Public Works paving, on June 25<sup>th</sup>, at 10:00am.

Gary Woodward, Auditor, discussed children of county employees benefiting from Job and Family Service's programs. Mr. Woodward also discussed fees going up for the maintenance of the Courthouse clock.

Judge Favreau discussed the current budget situation for the Clerk of Courts. The Commissioners explained that every nickel of General Fund money has been appropriated.

Nancy Robison and Amy Grove discussed landscaping in front of the Courthouse for the Master Gardner's program. The Commissioners advised the group to discuss their request with Judge Favreau.

Terry McGrew, Health Department, discussed Family and Children First and requested help from janitorial staff to help move office equipment for Help Me Grow.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, discussed purchasing a Fair Housing display board for the Morgan County Fair. Ms. Wells noted the Landlord/Tenant Seminar will be on June 20<sup>th</sup>, from 6-8pm. Ms. Wells will be speaking for Habitat for Humanity about Fair Housing, on June 19<sup>th</sup>.
