The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, March 26, 2007 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. The minutes of the March 19, 2007 meeting were read and approved.

Commissioners reported on their activities for the week March 19, 2007.

Commissioners Rick Shriver, Dean Cain, and Don Reynolds attended the Windsor Township meeting on Thursday, March 22, 2007.

Commissioner Rick Shriver on March 22, 2007, attended the United Way Policy Board meeting and the Morgan County Community Improvement Corporation - Large Business Committee meeting. On March 23, 2007, Mr. Shriver met with the Help Me Grow staff, MRDD President and Director to discuss the Help Me Grow Program.

Pam Montgomery, OSU Extension Office, discussed recent Family and Consumer Science programs. March 24, 2007, the 34<sup>th</sup> Annual Sewing Smorgasbord was held. Basics to a Household Budget was held on January 30, 2007. Behavior Management of Children was held on March 12, 2007. Ms. Montgomery partnered with the Morgan County Learning Center and offered a Stress Management program. Ms. Montgomery is active on the Morgan County Family and Children Council, Morgan County Collaborative Group and Suicide Coalition. The upcoming Family and Consumer Science programs are: "Do They Benefit from Chores?" on April 17, 2007; Cooperative Parenting and Divorce (six week program) starting on April 12, 2007 thru May 17, 2007; Sodium in the Diet at the Senior Nutrition Lunch program on March 26, 2007; Helping Children Cope with Divorce on May 15, 2007; and Behavior Management of Children on May 21, 2007. Ms. Montgomery will be presenting at Help Me Grow's Spank-Out Day on Discipline of Children.

Pam Montgomery, OSU Extension Office, discussed the 4-H program which she shares with Chris Penrose. The 4-H enrollment deadline is April 1, 2007. Ms. Montgomery, the 4-H Camp Director, has selected camp counselors and they've started their training sessions. Junior Leaders, a teen county wide leadership program, are planning the Office training sessions for Officer/Advisor Training on April 23, 2007 at the High School. 4-H CARTEENS, teen led traffic safety program for first time juvenile traffic offenders, has been meeting regularly since they reorganized last summer. A total of 13 youth have been required by Juvenile Court to attend the program with one of their parents. The Older Youth In-Training program was

added back to the county's 4-H program after 3 years of being absent. Ms. Montgomery noted New Advisor trainings have been completed for 2007 and total of 8 new advisors were trained.

Trudy Massey met with Commissioners and discussed the Lodging Tax. Morgan County presently has no county-wide lodging tax, which is paid on overnight accommodations.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, discussed a grant that Morgan County is eligible for to establish a federally qualified Health Clinic. Morgan is one of only 5 counties in Ohio that is eligible to apply for this funding. The funds will be used to create a community health center to provide medical, dental and psychiatric services to all residents. Ms. Wells also discussed Help Me Grow and Rural Public Transit. Both programs have been operated by MRDD, but are being moved to the county.

Ms. Wells also discussed a meeting with Paul Preece and Mr. and Mrs. Tomblin regarding Americans with Disabilities Act regulations at the Morgan County Court. They also discussed concerns with property taxes.

Jim Baker, Community Action, updated Commissioners with the Environmental Review for the CHIP program's Habitat Project and updated an agreement between Commissioners and Community Action concerning the CHIP Grant.

Commissioners are in receipt of a Certificate of Records Disposal, as submitted by Becky Cooley, Morgan County Recorder, for Chattel Mortgages Financing Statements from 1970 to 2002 and Uniform Commercial Code Financing Statements from 1970 to 2002.
