The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, May 14, 2007 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.  
The minutes of the May 7, 2007 meeting were read and approved.

**06-778** Motion by Mr. Dean Cain and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from May 7, 2007.

Commissioners reported on their activities for the week May 7, 2007.

Commissioner Dean Cain, on May 8<sup>th</sup>, met with Jim Barnhart and a couple of community service workers and had them move miscellaneous items to the Historical Society Museum. On May 9<sup>th</sup>, Mr. Cain attended the Morgan County Community Improvement Corporation meeting and spoke with Terry McGrew, Director, Health Department, concerning the Health Department's water.

Commissioner Rick Shriver, on May 8<sup>th</sup>, attended a meeting of the Board of Directors of the Muskingum Valley Community Health Centers. On May 9<sup>th</sup>, Mr. Shriver traveled to the Innovation Center in Athens, Ohio to discuss Broadband and IT projects in Appalachian Ohio and met with the Voinovich Center to discuss the CIC/Chamber of Commerce web project.

Commissioners Rick Shriver, Dean Cain, and Don Reynolds attended the Deerfield township meeting on May 10<sup>th</sup>.

Bill Greuey dropped off bills for the clean up of Upper Douda, in Malta. The Commissioners again commended the Malta Township Trustees on their efforts.

Darrin Carpenter inquired about High Street water line projects. Commissioners noted we are waiting on word from Poggemeyer Design group on the successful bidder.

Jeff Shaner, OSU Extension Office, inquired about the length of time the food stand will be in place at the Commons. Mr. Shaner noted a conference call on the 37/78 Corridor planning project set for May 14<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Shaner attended the "Doing the Deal" seminar on financing programs through the state and other private entities on May 15<sup>th</sup>. He also attended Community Development training. Mr. Shaner noted the Workforce Investment Board meets on May 17<sup>th</sup>. On May 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>, Mr. Shaner will attend meetings in Jackson and Belle Valley to propose a broadband project in all 29 Appalachian counties.

Tom Schott and Gary Miller, CONSOL-Central Ohio Coal requested the release of maintenance of County Roads 5 and 11. Mr. Miller and Steve Hook, Engineer, have been working on the roads to bring them back to county specifications. Consol had agreed to maintain the roads through April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2007.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, discussed a micro-enterprise grant program she is pursuing. Ms. Wells also discussed transit employees receiving time and a half for driving on recognized holidays. Ms. Wells noted the roof on the Learning Center should be completed this week.

Jim Ridenour, Job and Family Services, submitted leave requests and meeting requests for Jim Ridenour, DeeAnn Vandine and Heidi Burns to TANF Demo Grant meeting on June 12<sup>th</sup>, in Zanesville. Mr. Ridenour submitted a contract with MAXIMUS for Quarterly Information Consolidation System (QuIC) and Random Sampling System (RMS) for 7/1/07-6/30/08.

Commissioners are in receipt of a letter submitted by Steve Hook, Engineer, providing the list of certified attendees for the Morgan County Highway Department that completed the 2 day Chipper/Chainsaw training course May 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>. The course is part of The Ohio Local Technical Assistance Program thru ODOT FHWA.
