The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, November 5, 2007 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
The minutes of the October 29, 2007 meeting were read and approved.

Commissioners reported on their activities for the week October 29, 2007.

On Tuesday, Commissioner Cain attended the Buckeye Hills Hocking Valley Regional Development District meeting and met with Todd Sidwell to discuss a perspective business expanding in Morgan County.

On Wednesday, Commissioner Cain attended the Southeastern Ohio Regional Jail meeting and the Homecoming for the 2nd 174th Air Defense Artillery Regiment at Morgan High School.

On Wednesday, Commissioner Shriver met with the Chamber of Commerce banquet committee.

On Friday, Commissioner Cain met with Michelle Hyer, Buckeye Hills Hocking Valley Regional Development District, also met with Judge Favreau to discuss a grant for innovative youth employment & training programs for disadvantaged youth from the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services.

On Saturday, Commissioner Cain met with Terry Robison, EMA & OHS, to discuss the Homeland Security Grant. Commissioner Cain and Reynolds attended the Morgan County Homecoming in Malta.

Steve Hook, Engineer, discussed Morgan County being approved for funds from the Federal Highway Administration for a guardrail study. The Engineer's Office must hire an independent contractor to perform a CSTP Safety Study. The federal government will pay 90% of the costs for the study. The estimated cost will be \$31,432.

Jeff Shaner, OSU Extension, alerted the commissioners that the Morgan County Community Improvement Corporation will meet on November 8th, 9:00am, at the Learning Center. Mr. Shaner updated on the OSU Extension Office activities.

Jeff McInturf, Engineer's Office, discussed a public hearing for Bruner-Ramsey Subdivision situated in Marion Township. The hearing is set for November 19th, 9:30am.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services, submitted meeting requests for Steve Kinney to "OCDA-General Membership" meeting in Columbus, on November 15th; Vicki Quesinberry to "Ohio Job and Family Services Directors' Association" meeting in Columbus, on December 12th; and Vicki Quesinberry to "Canton District Directors' Association" meeting in Dennison, on November 6th. Ms. Quesinberry discussed a meeting at 1pm, on the 3rd Floor of the Riecker Building, on November 5th, to discuss a grant for innovative youth employment & training programs for disadvantaged youth from the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services.

Gary Woodward, Auditor, discussed the county's holiday schedule.

Mr. and Mrs. Hall discussed a concern with alcohol sales from a new commercial business on County Road 24 (Stoney Point Road). The Commissioners explained that there is no zoning in the county to prohibit commercial ventures in residential areas. The Halls' deed includes restrictions on commercial construction, but such restrictions are essentially unenforceable, or falls to the subdivision association (if one exists) to enforce the restrictions.

Shannon Wells and Traci Kidd, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, discussed the Morgan County Revolving Loan Fund from the Ohio Department of Development and the Revolving Loan Fund Committee. Jeff Shaner, OSU Extension Office, was also in attendance to discuss the revolving loan. Mrs. Wells noted the paving at the Health Center will begin November 6th and High Street in Malta is 100% complete. Mrs. Wells and Ms. Kidd will attend a meeting on November 6th with Pat Kelly to view the renovation plans for the Health Center at Dr. Murrell's Office. The "Continuum of Care" meeting will be held at Morgan Metropolitan Housing Authority on November 6th to discuss the Homelessness Grant that Morgan County received in 2006. A meeting is scheduled for the formation of a Non-Profit Board to operate the Morgan County Learning Center on November 8th at the Learning Center.

Commissioners are in receipt of a statement concerning the Morgan County Jail usage for October 2007. A total of 139 prisoners were kept in the Morgan County Jail to lower costs at the Southeastern Ohio Regional Joint Jail. This count is prisoners held here for at least one day each. Other prisoners who were brought for court and returned to the Regional Jail are not included in these figures.

Commissioners are in receipt of a letter submitted by David Brightbill, Washington-Morgan Community Action, providing written notification of an audit that was performed for their corporation. There were no findings or questioned costs related to funds provided to Morgan County.
