The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, September 24, 2007 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. The minutes of the September 17, 2007 meeting were read and approved.

Commissioners reported on their activities for the week September 17, 2007.

Commissioner Dean Cain attended the Employee Drug Free Workplace Training on September 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>.

Commissioner Dean Cain and Don Reynolds attended the Ohio Valley Employment Resource W.I.A. meeting on September 20<sup>th</sup>, in Marietta. On September 21<sup>st</sup>, Commissioner Cain and Reynolds attended the Drug Free Workplace Train the Trainer.

On Tuesday, September 18, Commissioner Shriver attended a meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Opera House, Incorporated. On Wednesday, September 19, Shriver attended a meeting of the Coalition of Concerned Citizens. On Friday, September 21, Shriver traveled to Zanesville to testify before Senator Sherrod Brown's conference on broadband and the urgency of the need for wider broadband deployment in Southeastern Ohio.

Pam Montgomery, OSU Extension Office, updated Commissioners on her 4-H and Family and Consumer Science activities/programs.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services, submitted meeting requests for Heidi Burns and Cheryl Bailey to Meigs County for PCSA Fiscal Training, on September 27<sup>th</sup>; Vicki Quesinberry and Dee Vandine to Columbus for TANF and Director Training, on October 22<sup>nd</sup>-24<sup>th</sup>.

John Sampson, Transit, submitted a break down for trips made by Rural Public Transit from January to August 2007. A total of 744 trips were made for Elderly Disabled, 904 General Service Riders, 3288 Contracted Elderly Disabled, and 1846 Contracted Other Riders. A total of 256 No Shows, 247 Cancellations, 39 Trip Denials, 44 Missed Trips, and 11 Complaints were reported. Commissioner Shriver commented that Morgan County Rural Transit is experiencing "growth pains." The ridership is expanding rapidly and he acknowledged that some problems are inevitable. The commissioners discussed the importance of public transit in rural communities like Morgan County, especially in light of rising fuel prices.

Melinda Jeffers and Jim Greer, Medical Mutual of Ohio, Gary Woodward, Auditor, Steve Hook, Engineer, and Vicki Quesinberry, Director of Job and Family Services, discussed the county's health insurance renewal with Commissioners. That was followed by a meeting of the county employees' insurance committee.

Brent Smith and Gary Williams, Washington State Community College, discussed a final performance report needed for the Morgan County Community College Grant #P1162040004 from the United States Department of Education.

Jack Bonsell informed the commissioners that he will be working as the Regional Project Representative for Quality Control on the West Malta Rural Water District Project.

Warren Fusner discussed with Commissioners the closure of a road in Chesterhill. Commissioner Dean Cain referred Fusner to the Engineer's Office to discuss the matter.

Commissioners signed the Addendum to Community-Based Corrections Programs 2008 Subsidy Grant Agreement, submitted by Alma Tennant, Clerk, County Court. The grant award was increased by \$656.00.
