

**MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Wednesday, January 16, 2008 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. The minutes of the January 7, 2008 meeting were read and approved.

**08-15** Motion by Mr. Dean Cain and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from January 7, 2008.

Commissioners reported on their activities for the week January 7, 2008.

On Thursday, Commissioners Cain and Reynolds attended the Morgan County Community Improvement Corporation meeting. Mr. Cain also met with Wade Benjamin, ABC Manufacturing, and attended the Morgan County Coordinated Transportation Plan meeting at MRDD. Mr. Reynolds also attended the Junior Fair Board, Sale Committee, meeting.

Pam Montgomery, OSU Extension Office, provided an update of the activities and programs currently going on with 4-H, Family and Consumer Sciences. On January 15<sup>th</sup>, Mrs. Montgomery will be providing a 2 hour seminar for parents going through a divorce or dissolution titled "Helping Children Cope with Divorce." From January 24<sup>th</sup> through February 28<sup>th</sup> a six week program will be offered to help parents shift from the roles of former spouses to co-parents (topics will include anger management, communication and conflict). The program is titled "Cooperative Parenting & Divorce." To register for these programs and many more, contact the Extension Office.

Gary Woodward, Auditor, submitted to commissioners a Certificate of County Auditor, stating that the total appropriations from each fund **Do Exceed** the last amended official estimate of resources for the fiscal year beginning January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services, submitted meeting requests for Cheryl Bailey to "Beyond the Silence" training, on January 16, 17, and 18, in Athens; Cheryl Bailey to "Family and Child Assessment" training, on March 13 and 14, in Athens; Cheryl Bailey to "Finalization Adoption Services" training, on February 15, in Athens; Candi Drake and Kim Reed to "Roundtable Meeting -Work Activities" on February 19, in Marietta; Mary Woodward to "CRISE Training- Fundamentals of IM Caseworker" on February 25-29, in Columbus.

Cindy Cunningham, liaison from Congressman Zack Space's Office, attended the meeting to advise the Commissioners that Congressman will be at Ohio University in Zanesville, on January 25<sup>th</sup>, to launch the "Renew OH18." This is an initiative to revitalize Southeastern Ohio's economy and develop a long term plan for Ohio's 18<sup>th</sup> District, focusing on the following issues: Broadband, Agriculture, Alternative Energy,

and Healthcare. This meeting is open to the public. Ms. Cunningham also stated the Fiscal Year 2009 Appropriations Request Form is due February 25<sup>th</sup> and inquired if Commissioners had any updates or projects the Congressman should be aware of. Commissioner Shriver provided an update on ABC Manufacturing and discussed the need for Broadband T1 connectivity at the Morgan County Family Health Center. Shriver also explained that State Route 60 is the primary artery for Morgan County's manufacturers. Increased trucking has caused a concern for improved shoulders from the Muskingum County line to Duncan Falls. Ms. Cunningham made note of the concern. Commissioner Shriver told Ms. Cunningham that the General Fund account is effectively broke, and relies primarily on sales tax. Unless an operating levy is passed the General Fund will struggle for the next few years. Commissioners thanked Ms. Cunningham for coming in.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, introduced the new CEO of the Muskingum Valley Health Centers, Lisa King. Dr. Murrell's office was transferred from Primecare to the Muskingum Valley Health Centers as of January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008. Ms. King noted she appreciates the Commissioners having everything in place on time. Mrs. Wells stated they are working on an ARC application from Buckeye Hills for medical equipment. Ms. King noted the following services they want to add to the Health Center: Gynecology, Pediatrics, Dermatology, and Diabetic services. Mental Health and Dental services are currently being worked on. Renovations to the Muskingum Valley Health Clinic have been put on hold. Ms. King is concerned about space. Discussion was held concerning the use of some underutilized space within the Learning Center. Other options were also discussed. Ms. King is not opposed to having 2 locations if necessary. In depth strategic and business planning on the medical needs of Morgan County needs to be done. Commissioner Shriver explained the residents of Morgan County need to be informed that they can get quality medical care in the county. Ms. King agreed, and said that the Muskingum Valley Health Center is not a free clinic and a lot of work needs to be done to clarify this. Commissioners agreed that is a perception that needs to be dealt with. Mrs. Wells and Ms. King thanked the Commissioners for their time and will keep them informed.

Linda Sheets, Office on Aging, discussed the cost of the health insurance for her office and noted the adjustments in schedules which have been made in order for her office to fall within budget.

Amy Grove, Travel and Tourism, discussed the County Wide Lodging Tax. A Morgan County Convention and Tourism Bureau is forming to develop and implement a lodging or "bed" tax to help generate additional revenue. The proposal calls for a 3% lodging tax. The Commissioners discussed that most overnight stays in Morgan County are from transient or business travelers, and the lodging tax would not burden the average Morgan County taxpayer. Average room rates in the county are low enough that the bed tax would be a very small amount. For example, an \$80 room charge would incur a lodging tax of \$2.40. The revenues would be used to help promote travel and tourism.
