

**MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
RIECKER BUILDING**

The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, April 7, 2008 with the following members present:

Don Reynolds, Vice-President
Rick Shriver, Member

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
The minutes of the March 31, 2008 meeting were read and approved.

08-165 Motion by Mr. Dean Cain and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from March 31, 2008.

Commissioners are in receipt of a letter submitted by Barbara J. Davis, R.A., Executive Director, Transitions Ins., requesting the release of marriage license fees and divorce/dissolution fees that are due for the first quarter of 2008.

Commissioners granted permission for Susan Cunningham to hold a prayer meeting at the Grove the 3rd Saturday of every month.

Commissioners are in receipt of a letter submitted by an anonymous person suggesting the construction of a skateboard park.

Commissioners are in receipt of a statement concerning the Morgan County Jail usage for March 2008. A total of 160 prisoners were kept in the Morgan County Jail to lower costs at the Southeastern Ohio Regional Joint Jail. This count is prisoners held here for at least one day each. Other prisoners who were brought for court and returned to the Regional Jail are not included in these figures.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services, submitted meeting requests for Freda VanHorn and Kim Reed to "Out of School Youth and Hard to Serve Youth" on May 5th and 6th, in Columbus; Cheryl Bailey, Jody Murray to "Title IV-E Statewide" meeting, on April 11th, in Columbus. Union negotiations for 3560A will be on April 8th, at 11:00am. Ms. Quesinberry submitted a copy of the Agreement between Morgan County Job and Family Services and AFSCME Ohio Council 8, AFL-CIO Local 3560, for review.

Ed Sisler, The Humane Society Serving Clark County, Inc., and several concerned citizens entered the Commissioner's Office early Monday morning with anticipation to hear an update on Jeff Driggs, Dog Warden.

08-168 Motion by Mr. Rick Shriver and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds for Jeff Driggs, Dog Warden, to tender his resignation by 4:00pm, April 7th, 2008, or Mr. Driggs will be dismissed from his position effective immediately.

Vote Don Reynolds- yea, Rick Shriver- yea, Dean Cain- abstain. Motion Carried

Ed Sisler, The Humane Society Serving Clark County, Inc., commended the commissioners on the decision they've made and explained that he was here on his own time, not taxpayers. Mr. Sisler inquired why Commissioner Cain didn't disclose himself previously being the Morgan County Dog Warden last Monday, March 31st. Mr. Sisler feels Mr. Cain knew the job duties required for a Dog Warden and then asked for Commissioner Cain's resignation. Mr. Sisler noted he has several donated supplies that will be brought to Morgan County and Morgan County had the first pay-in to the Treasurer's Office for the adoption of a dog. One dog was euthanized by injection and one dog was still at the pound. There will be a weekly transport of dogs from the Morgan County Dog Pound to Clark County. It is understood where Morgan County is financially and Mr. Sisler will pursue funds to help. Mr. Sisler noted he doesn't like for anyone to lose their job and there are several tasks ahead that need to be accomplished first: Dog Pound in good shape, Volunteers in order, Establish line of Communication, Who will train the new Dog Warden for Morgan County, and Correcting the EPA issue. Concerned citizens inquired about kennel and dog license. Mr. Sisler noted they are not a priority now but noted the Auditor's office should endorse two or three locations for persons to obtain their license. It was noted that redemption and adoption fees would increase the Dog Kennel Fund. Commissioner Reynolds asked that everyone please be patient with them while they correct the wrongdoings.

A concerned citizen commended Commissioner Shriver and Reynolds for voting responsibly and inquired how long it will take for a new Dog Warden to be in place. Commissioners noted they need to advertise for two weeks.

A concerned citizen noted he has high regards for Jeff Driggs and believes this is a Morgan County matter not a state problem.

A concerned citizen inquired on the amount of dog licenses sold within the county and suggested Morgan County should obtain a new dog pound. Commissioners replied around that about 2600 licenses were sold.

A concerned citizen from Washington County discussed an incident occurring on September 23, 1999 where she witnessed a steal cable, noose, and several dog collars attached with dog tags with people's phone numbers and addresses. Washington County helps animals everywhere and provide spay and neuter clinics. Dogs were witnessed in the dog pound with no water or food. It was noted she had an appointment with previous Commissioners and she was told bullets were cheaper. A group of volunteers from Washington County want to help aid in donations for supplies.

Ralph Strode and Fred Lynn, discussed the situation with Jeff Driggs, Dog Warden and inquired why don't Commissioner Shriver and Reynolds resign.

Jeff Shaner, OSU Extension, noted the ribbon cutting for EZ Grout will be on May 8th, at 11am and a building tour until 4pm.

Peggy Barnes, Recorder's Office, inquired how the Conveyance Tax will be disbursed, monthly or quarterly. Commissioner Cain informed Mrs. Barnes whichever way the Auditor's Office thinks is best.

Jerry Gibson, Spy Glass, explained Spy Glass is a Telecommunications Expense Management company. They audit an organization's local, long distance, cell phone and internet billings to help lower expenses. Mr. Gibson noted they have 600 clients, of which most of them are in Ohio. There are three types of recommendations: Billing inaccuracy, Elimination opportunities, and General Cost Reduction. On average the company saves organizations 24%. In order to get started they would need two months of bills, copy of any contracts, and a letter of authorization. The analytical work may take up to six weeks to discover any recommendations. There is neither a start up fee nor an assessment fee. The only cost to the county would depend on which recommendations the Commissioners implemented. On any billing inaccuracies the split would be 50/50, for any elimination opportunities or any general cost reduction the fee would be determined by the amount found times 12. Commissioners thanked Mr. Gibson for coming in and said they would like more time to discuss this. Mr. Gibson plans to contact the Commissioner's Office on Monday, April 14th.

A public hearing for the CHIP program and the Housing Advisory Committee meeting was held in the Commissioner's Office at 3:00pm, by Jim Baker, Washington-Morgan Community Action.

Carl Williams, Morgan County Fair Board, discussed Commissioners being mandated by the state to appropriate \$2400.00 to the Fair Board. Commissioner Cain noted it was an oversight and it would be corrected.

A couple of volunteers requested supplies to begin cleaning the inside of the Dog Pound.

A concerned citizen inquired what exactly Jeff Driggs, Dog Warden, did wrong. Commissioner Cain noted the violation with the EPA was the illegal disposal of animal carcasses and admitted the Commissioner's office is also to blame. Commissioner Reynolds noted he has nothing against Jeff Driggs and it's unfortunate that it had to come to this. The concerned citizen feels that the Ohio Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals is after Jeff Driggs and won't be happy until they are running this county.
