

**MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
RIECKER BUILDING**

The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, May 19, 2008 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. The minutes of the May 12, 2008 meeting were read and approved.

**08-249** Motion by Mr. Dean Cain and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from May 12, 2008.

Commissioners reported on their activities for the week May 12, 2008.

On Monday, Commissioners Cain, Reynolds and Shriver attended the LEPC meeting.

On Wednesday, Commissioners Cain and Shriver attended the Farm Bureau meeting.

Commissioner Cain met with a local businessman and Jeff Shaner, OSU Extension, to discuss starting a business in the county, and attended the Kinship Care Banquet at the Stockport Mill.

On Thursday, Commissioner Cain attended the produce auction in Chesterhill.

On Thursday, Commissioner Shriver attended an agriculture legislative policy briefing in Columbus and attended a meeting of the Ohio Chapter of the National Association of Social Workers.

Mike Totman, Court Administrator and Chief Probation Officer, discussed paying finance and late charges for the county credit card out of his own pocket due to a County policy which prohibits the county to pay them. Mr. Totman stated he's never had finance/late charges in the past and it's under the discretion of the Commissioners to approve the Auditor's office to pay them. Mr. Totman also stated that a county employee cannot pay into a government fund.

Jeff Shaner, OSU Extension Office, discussed a discrepancy on when the Extension Levy needs to be renewed. The levy was passed during the Primary Election of 2004. This was a five year levy for tax years 2004 thru 2008, collection to begin in 2005. Commissioners recommended Mr. Shaner contact the Secretary of State for clarification. Mr. Shaner reported he will attend the Buckeye Hills Hocking Valley Regional Development District, Comprehensive Economic Strategy meeting, on May 22<sup>nd</sup> and June 5<sup>th</sup>, and the Lead Management meeting, May 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Della Bratton had a conference call with Commissioners. Ms. Bratton noted Congress updated the benefits for Veterans. The benefits had not been updated since 1944 during President Roosevelt's administration. Ms. Bratton mentioned she had read that Ohio lost 200 million dollars by not using federal funds for job

training. This year, Ohio was granted 160 million dollars in Federal Funds. Ms. Bratton stated these funds need to be monitored better and believes there is no reason for federal money to be returned concerning the unemployment rate. Ms. Bratton inquired on gas vouchers issued by Job and Family Services. Commissioner Shriver explained gas vouchers are issued to individuals attending college and persons needing help getting to doctor appointments. Ms. Bratton inquired on Transit employees receiving a fifty dollar gas voucher as a safety incentive. Commissioners stated they are being paid for out of Transit's budget which is reimbursed by the Ohio Department of Transportation, and it's legal.
