

**MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
RIECKER BUILDING**

The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, June 23, 2008 with the following members present:

Don Reynolds, Vice-President  
Rick Shriver, Member

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.  
The minutes of the June 16, 2008 meeting were read and approved.

**08-298** Motion by Mr. Dean Cain and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from June 16, 2008.

**Vote Don Reynolds- yea, Rick Shriver- yea, Dean Cain- yea. Motion Carried**

Commissioners reported on their activities for the week June 16, 2008.

On Monday, Commissioner Shriver attended the dedication of the Cambridge Post Office in honor Senator John Glenn.

On Tuesday, Commissioner Shriver attended the Morgan County Manufacturer's Council Meeting.

On Wednesday, Commissioner Shriver presided over the Morgan County Chamber of Commerce meeting.

Ruth and Lee Beard inquired who put a mortgage on their house. Mr. Beard submitted paperwork listing the Morgan County Commissioners as a lien holder. The Beards received help from Washington-Morgan Community Action to make improvements to their house. Commissioners informed Mr. and Mrs. Beard, Washington-Morgan Community Action work through the Commissioners' Office and the Commissioners Office would contact Jim Baker, Washington-Morgan Community Action, to discuss the situation with him.

Jeff Shaner, OSU Extension, reported the Morgan County Community Improvement Corporation, Special Meeting, will be held at the Learning Center, on June 24<sup>th</sup>, at 9:00am. Mr. Shaner informed Commissioners he will be attending a meeting with Miba Sinter at the Ohio Department of Development, Department Finance Advisory Committee, in Columbus, on June 30<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Shaner brought to the Commissioners attention that the Boy Scouts of America is looking for 5000 acres to hold their jamboree every four years. A facility would be built that would operate year round. Pam Montgomery will be the new County Extension Director, starting July 1<sup>st</sup>, after Jeff Shaner's retirement on June 30<sup>th</sup>. The Extension Office is preparing for 4-H judging and 4-H camp.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services, discussed the 2002 audit. Ms. Quesinberry also reported there was an incorrect allocation in the 2009 State match at an estimated \$39,000. The low divorce rate among couples with children affects the child support base. Ms. Quesinberry plans to research records and verify shortfall from as reported by the State; a layoff in Children Services is probable.

John McCort, Village Administrator, discussed performing a smoke test to the storm/sewer drain mid-August. All homes with gutters and spouting running into the storm/sewer drain will need to be corrected. This is a violation with the Environmental Protection Agency. A letter will be issued to any household in violation of this regulation after the smoke test.

Doug Matheney discussed owners of pit bulls being required to carry insurance. If this is the law, and said owners do not have insurance on their dogs, he requested the dogs be picked up by the county dog warden. It was also mentioned the pit bulls were tied up with a rope and Mr. Matheney feels that is not considered having control of that dog.

Gary Woodward, Auditor, discussed the fire extinguishers in the Riecker Building needing hydrostatically tested this year.

Shannon Wells and Traci Kidd, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, reported Mrs. Wells will be attending a meeting with Sherrod Brown, at Miba and participate in a Clean Ohio Revitalization Video Conference on July 1<sup>st</sup>. Mrs. Wells will also attend a Downtown Revitalization meeting with Heritage of Ohio and Ohio Department of Development.

Steve Hook, Engineer, submitted pictures showing the restoration progress at the Helmick Bridge. All materials are on site and the contract deadline for completion is August 7<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Hook stated nails being dumped on roads in York Township continue to be a problem. A magnet has been ordered that will be attached to a county vehicle to help pick up nails. Mr. Hook reported this year only, there is additional money signed by the Governor available for Issue I, Round 23. The Engineer's Office will have a paving project and the Village of McConnelsville will be going after meters. Issue I, Round 22 will be going out for bid soon. Mr. Hook discussed his support of the implementation of a county permissive tax in the amount of five dollars added to license plates. Mr. Hook stated the estimated 16,000 vehicles within the county will provide his office with \$80,000 to help take care of county roads.
