

**MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, July 14, 2008 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
The minutes of the July 7, 2008 meeting were read and approved.

08-326 Motion by Mr. Dean Cain and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from July 7, 2008.

Commissioners reported on their activities for the week July 7, 2008.

On Thursday, Commissioners Cain and Shriver attended the Penn Township meeting.

Mike Reed sat in during the Commissioners' meeting.

Commissioners granted permission for United Telephone Ohio DBA- Embarq, to place facilities along side of County Road 53, located in the Township of Marion, Morgan County, Ohio, for a .67 inch diameter copper line. The construction of this project will begin on or about August 15th, 2008 and will be completed by September 4th, 2008.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services, provided an update on the A-133 Audits.

Pam Montgomery, OSU Extension Office, inquired how often Commissioners would like her to report to them. Commissioners stated bi-weekly would be sufficient. Mrs. Montgomery stated Chris Penrose was attending the National Ag. Agency Conference and provided an update on the current activities for Family and Consumer Science and 4-H. Mrs. Montgomery informed Commissioners on beginning to formulate a levy campaign.

Steve Hook, Engineer, submitted pictures displaying progress in the restoration of the Helmick Covered Bridge and discussed a physician leaving the network in the county's health insurance. Commissioners informed Mr. Hook he needed to contact Jim Greer to discuss the situation.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, reported she will be attending an Economic Development Networking Day on Tuesday, July 15th, in Marietta, sponsored by the Governor's Office.

John Singree discussed waiving the late fees on the purchase of dog tags to help people out.

Linda Sheets, Office on Aging, reported a van driver submitting her resignation effective the end of July.

John Sampson, Transit, provided an update on transportation for the month of June and discussed contacting churches to discuss Transit providing transportation for seniors to Sunday services. During the month of June a total of 160 Elderly Disabled, 238 General Service Riders, 218 Contract-Elderly Disabled, and 330 Contract-Other Riders were transported. A total of 21,397 miles were driven during this month.

Della Bratton telephoned Commissioners and discussed MRDD. Ms. Bratton discussed property owners financing a Private Non-Profit organization and MRDD being on the ballot. Ms. Bratton feels people should donate to a Private Non-Profit organization but not taxed upon. Commissioner Shriver stated MRDD is NOT on the ballot this year and is not due to be on the ballot for two years. Commissioner Shriver mentioned he has been contacted by several people to discuss the services to the clients within MRDD. Commissioner Shriver also indicated that he had spoken with State MRDD Director, who saw no problems with the operation of the MRDD at the time. The Commissioners discussed the composition of the MRDD Board with Mrs. Bratton. A discussion was held concerning MRDD entering into the operation of a Group Home. MRDD wants to purchase homes and provide their own Group Home. Ms. Bratton feels Governor Strickland needs to be notified to discuss the direction MRDD is heading.
