

**MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
RIECKER BUILDING**

The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, August 11, 2008 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. The minutes of the August 4, 2008 meeting were read and approved.

**08-363** Motion by Mr. Dean Cain and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from August 4, 2008.

**Vote Don Reynolds- yea, Rick Shriver- yea, Dean Cain- yea. Motion Carried**

Commissioners reported on their activities for the week August 4, 2008.

On Wednesday, Commissioner Shriver met with Gary Combs to discuss a business project.

On Friday, Commissioner Reynolds attended the Area Agency on Aging meeting in Marietta.

**08-365** Motion by Mr. Don Reynolds and seconded by Mr. Rick Shriver to award the contract to Shelly and Sands for Round 22, Issue I- Ohio Public Works Paving project, as requested by Steve Hook, Engineer.

Chris Penrose, OSU Extension, noted discounted tickets for the Farm Science Review on September 16-18, are available at the OSU Extension Office. Mr. Penrose noted the Junior Fair Board will be having a workday on August 12<sup>th</sup>, Horse Skilathons will be on August 14<sup>th</sup>, Field Livestock Day will be held on August 18<sup>th</sup>, 6-9pm.

Della Bratton held a conference call with Commissioners discussing OSU Extension's levy being on the ballot this fall. Ms. Bratton wants to know how many lives the Extension office has touched to justify a levy being on the ballot. Ms. Bratton inquired if the Extension Office provides monthly reports. Commissioner Shriver informed Ms Bratton, they report on activities every two weeks. It's not a quantitative report. Ms. Bratton inquired why the Extension Office doesn't pay rent for space used in the Riecker Building. Commissioners informed Bratton, according to the Ohio Revised Code, the Commissioners are required to provide them a space. Commissioner Shriver stated Legislature expects

OSU to provide services unique to each county based on demographics and population. Each county will have to help fund. Ms. Bratton feels OSU sells 4-H to pass the levy and feels they don't touch that many lives within the county. A discussion was held concerning the Carlos Riecker Fund not being used to pay for debts, as provided in Judge Riecker's will. Commissioner Shriver stated the original funds as a gift from Carlos Riecker are gone; they were used to renovate the building. Ms. Bratton noted Congressman Zack Space's meeting at the VFW in Malta was beneficial. Congressman Zack Space supports legislation for mileage reimbursement for Veterans.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services, submitted a copy of the Contract for Services between Morgan County Department of Job and Family Services and the Morgan County Health Department for the Help Me Grow Program. Ms. Quesinberry submitted meeting request for Ginger Bowen to "Quarterly Fraud Control", on September 10<sup>th</sup>, in Athens.

A bid opening for the Community Development Travel/Tourism and Workforce Development programs was held in the Commissioners' Office.

**08-367** Motion by Mr. Rick Shriver and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the following:

WHEREAS the Morgan County Commissioners have entered into an agreement with the Morgan County Humane Society for the enforcement of dog licensing, and the capture, retrieval, impoundment, care, adoption and disposition of dogs in the County, and

WHEREAS it is legal and lawful to furnish a vehicle and funding to an officer of the Humane Society who serves as the County Dog Warden, as provided in Section 1717.05 of the Ohio Revised Code, and further confirmed in Opinion 1952 OAG 1321,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Morgan County Commissioners shall provide automobile insurance for the truck owned and operated by the Morgan County Humane Society, the premiums for which are to be paid from the Dog and Kennel Fund, and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Morgan County Commissioners shall provide fuel for the vehicle, to be paid from the Dog and Kennel Fund, and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the vehicle is used solely for the purpose of fulfilling the duties of the Morgan County Dog Warden.

**Vote Don Reynolds- yea, Rick Shriver- yea, Dean Cain- nay. Motion Carried**

Commissioner Cain stated the Prosecutor advised the Commissioners not to enter into a contract with the Humane Society, and he believes this will cost the county money.

Robert Wiseman, R.W. Mechanical Services and Contracting Ltd, discussed a defective circuit board within the heating ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) system. A discussion was held concerning converting the system from a proprietary to a non-proprietary system. Commissioner Cain informed Mr. Wiseman the county is financially unstable. Commissioners are willing to review the proposal when submitted.

Bernie Kinder and Brian Kampton, The Ohio Plan, Health Division, discussed providing health insurance for county employees. The Commissioners will have to name Mr. Kinder as the Agent of Record in order to obtain a quote. Jim Greer, Greer Insurance, is the current Agent of Record.

Commissioners met with Jim Greer, Greer Insurance, to discuss obtaining a quote for health insurance from The Ohio Plan. Mr. Greer feels it is not the best way for the county to go and noted the county's rich benefits and claims history inhibit other insurance providers from quoting insurance for the county.

Shannon Wells and Traci Kidd, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, discussed electrical work cost estimates received for the Community Development Block Grant, Formula '07, Village of McConnelsville Opera House Project.

**08-368** Motion by Mr. Don Reynolds and seconded by Mr. Rick Shriver to table the cost estimates received from Jim Eppley in the amount of \$4560.00, Ridgewind in the amount of \$7825.00 and Pierce Electric in the amount of \$15030.88 for the Community Development Block Grant, Formula '07, Opera House Project; also table the alternate cost estimates received for the upstairs projector room of the Opera House from Jim Eppley in the amount of \$2528.00, Ridgewind in the amount of \$5550.00, and Pierce Electric in the amount of \$7116.62, for further review by Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office.

Mrs. Wells submitted the \$58,000 Temporary Assistance for Needy Families proposal and a \$100,000 Appalachian Regional Commission grant. Mrs. Wells attended the Malta Township Trustee meeting on August 7<sup>th</sup>. Mrs. Wells reported serving on two new boards: Morgan County Learning Center Board and the Buckeye Hills Hocking Valley Revolving Loan Fund Board.

Mark Moellendick, Fire Department, requested the half mill (0.5) Ambulance Levy be put on the ballot for the November 2008 election, for renewal. Also, an additional one (1) mill levy to be put on the ballot for the November 2008 election. There has been no increase since 1994 and this will provide the full county with seven day twenty-four hour coverage.

The Commissioners agreed that it should be up to the voters of Morgan County to decide on the Ambulance Levy, and so they will allow the levy to appear on the November ballot.
