The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, June 1, 2009 with the following members present:

Don Reynolds, Vice-President

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
The minutes of the May 26, 2009 meeting were read and approved.

09-268 Motion by Mr. Dean Cain and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from May 26, 2009.

Becky Thompson, Dog Warden, reported traveling 230.5 miles responding to dog calls. Mrs. Thompson stated 5 dogs were in the Dog Pound. Zero dogs were destroyed.

A concerned citizen discussed various township and county roads within Morgan County.

Pam Montgomery, OSU Extension, updated Commissioners on the following programs: Chris Penrose will be presenting at the Annual Farm Bureau meeting on June 6th, and Invasive Species program will be held on June 8th, Master Gardeners will meet on June 18th at 9:30am, State Fair Horse meetings for those wanting to tryout will be held on June 4th or June 15th at 7pm, the Market Livestock tagging deadline is June 5th, Camp counselors continue to meet for training and workday to plan camp for 2009, Junior Leaders will be working in the flower beds at the Riecker Building on June 4th from 2:30pm - 5pm, or until done. They will be cleaning out trash, planting annual flowers, a little mulching and trimming bushes. Hospitality training and Team building activities with the Department of Job and Family Services Workforce summer employment program will be held on June 17th. Chris Penrose has proposed to do some training on June 16th with the same group on landscaping and gardening. Master Gardeners also discussing projects with the summer employment program. Community Development Educator from Noble County provided Shannon Well, Grant Writer for Morgan County, information on the Enterprise Zone and Tax Incentive Review Council. The next monthly Nutrition program at MCUM Jesus Loves Me Thrift Shop will be held on June 11th, 10am - 1pm. Program Basics to a Household Budget is scheduled for June 8th, 10am - Noon.
