

**MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, June 8, 2009 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
The minutes of the June 1, 2009 meeting were read and approved.

09-275 Motion by Mr. Dean Cain and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from June 1, 2009.

Commissioners are in receipt of a letter submitted by Central Ohio Coal Company requesting a Phase III release for 85.6 acres affected by the aforementioned coal mine and reclamation permit, located in Section Nos. 27, 34 and 35, Bristol Township, and Section Nos. 1, 2 and 11 in Meigsville Township, Morgan County, Ohio.

Becky Thompson, Dog Warden, reported traveling 195.5 miles responding to dog calls. Mrs. Thompson stated 6 dogs were picked up. Four dogs were euthanized.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services, submitted meeting requests for Heidi Burns, Wanda Maghes, and Jenna Hopkins to "QUIC+ Usergroup Training", on July 14, in Columbus; Heidi Burns to "Fiscal Training", on June 29th, in Athens.

Darlene and Harold Westfall, Becky Thompson, Dog Warden, requested Commissioners attempt to obtain the Pound Keeper's Book from Tammy Ray, former Dog Warden. Commissioners stated the book should have been returned when Mrs. Ray turned everything else in. The Pound Keeper's Book is county property and the Commissioners are uncertain why it wasn't turned in. A certified letter will be mailed to Mrs. Ray. Mrs. Westfall inquired on the time line for the book to be returned. Commissioners agreed to give Tammy 10 days to reply to the letter.

Jeff King, Riecker Maintenance/Custodian, submitted his two week notice and resigned.

Trevor Vessels, Ohio Jobs and Growth Plan, informed Commissioners of a proposal to place one first-class casino in the following four of Ohio's largest cities: Cleveland, Cincinnati, Columbus and Toledo. Mr. Vessels stated the following:

- 20,000 new jobs (not all permanent)
- \$1 billion currently being spent on gaming in other states (Indiana, Michigan, West Virginia and Pennsylvania)
- \$200 million in guaranteed fees to the state for workforce training
- Ohio guaranteed 33% of all revenues
- Local control of tax revenue: \$651 million to counties, 8 largest cities and every public school district in Ohio in the first year
- \$1.97 billion in projected revenue in first full year of operation- \$2.34 billion by 2017
- Total tax revenue to Morgan County and school districts: \$688,361 per year
- \$1 billion minimum in mandated private investment

Mr. Vessels stated the following persons back this proposal:

Dan Gilbert

- Majority owner of the NBA's Cleveland Cavaliers
- Operates Quicken Loans Arena in Downtown Cleveland

Penn National Gaming, Inc.

- One of the largest publicly traded gaming companies in America
- Owner of Raceway Park in Toledo

Ohio Jobs and Growth Committee

- Chaired by Charlie Luken, former Congressman and past Mayor of Cincinnati

The General Assembly must pass enabling legislation within 6 months of passage, establishes Ohio Casino Control Commission. This will be a bi-partisan 7 member panel appointed by the Governor. Ohio Senate must approve nominations. There will be no more than 4 members affiliated with the same political party. The Ohio Casino Control Commission will have the following duties: License and regulate casino operators and key employees, oversee all gaming, and ensure public trust and confidence in casino gaming in Ohio.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, and John Sampson, Transit, met with Commissioners. A discussion was held concerning contracting with a local entity.

09-283 Motion by Mr. Don Reynolds and seconded by Mr. Mike Reed to hire three full time drivers with no set hours for Transit: Susan Harry, Marvin Weaver, and Jeff King. The new hires were selected by seniority and a performance driven basis. The new hires will start a new three month probationary period. Each driver will be paid \$8.00 per hour and will be funded entirely from the Transit budget.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, discussed the Muskingum County Business Incubator wanting to partner with Morgan County. This is a non-profit organization that assists small business in Muskingum County. They received a grant program to encourage small business startup in additional counties. Each county would receive \$3000 for marketing material. Mrs. Wells also discussed the Revolving Loan fund.

Linda Sheets, Office on Aging, discussed the Senior Levy being on the November 3rd Election. I discussion was held concerning the Senior Farmers Market. Mrs. Sheets stated Morgan County didn't

receive all the coupons they were supposed to. Morgan County was supposed to receive 151 and they only received 134. Commissioners intend to contact Buckeye Hills for clarification.

Tim Friedburg telephoned Commissioner Mike Reed to inquire about tax evasion cases and uncollected taxes from oil and gas companies.

Morgan County Commissioners signed a Property Lease Agreement between Ohio Power Company and the Morgan County Commissioners for property situated in Morgan County (10447 South Cumberland Coal Field-Lottie Ferguson Tract MMO-2A). The Lease shall be for the term of three years commencing on the first day of June 2009. Commissioners would like to note this is a yard waste dump. It is not for the disposal of furniture, appliances, etc.

The Morgan County Commissioners received the Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue regarding the Ambulance Levy.

DECLARING THE AMOUNT OF TAXES THAT MAY BE RAISED BY LEVY AT THE MAXIMUM RATE AUTHORIZED BY LAW WITHOUT A VOTE OF ELECTORS TO BE INSUFFICIENT AND DECLARING THE NECESSITY TO A LEVY IN EXCESS OF SUCH RATE.

Be it resolved by the Morgan County Board of Commissioners, Morgan County, Ohio all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION I. That the amount of taxes that may be raised by the levy of taxes at the minimum rate authorized by O.R.C. 5705.19 on the taxable property in said County will be insufficient to provide adequate amount of necessary requirements of said County, and it is necessary for the purpose of providing additional funds for ambulance service for Morgan County for a period of five years at a rate in excess of the maximum rate authorized by O.R.C. 5705.19.

SECTION II. That it will be necessary to pass the levy for taxes for tax years 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013, being a additional tax of 1.00 mills on each dollar of tax valuation for five (5) years (which amounts to ten (10) cents for each One Hundred Dollars (\$100 of valuation), of the taxable property within Morgan County in excess of the rate authorized by O.R.C. 5705.19.

SECTION III. Be it further resolved that said levy be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next preceding the election, if a majority of electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

SECTION IV. That the clerk be and is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Morgan County Board of Elections in order that the said board of Elections may make the necessary arrangements of submission of such questions to the electors of Morgan County at the General Election on November 3, 2009.
