

**MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, August 3, 2009 with the following members present:

Dean Cain, President
Don Reynolds, Vice-President
Mike Reed, Member

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
The minutes of the July 27, 2009 meeting were read and approved.

09-362 Motion by Mr. Dean Cain and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from July 27, 2009.

Commissioners are in receipt of the Morgan County Jail usage for the month of July 2009 to reduce costs at the Southeastern Ohio Regional Joint Jail. The total bed days for month of July were 161. This count is prisoners held here for at least one day each and other prisoners were also brought for court and returned are in addition to these figures.

Commissioners are in receipt of a letter submitted by Central Ohio Coal Company requesting a Phase III release for 31.7 acres affected by the aforementioned coal mine and reclamation permit, located in Section Nos. 18, 19 and 30 Manchester Township, Morgan County, Ohio.

A request was submitted by Embarq Telephone Co. to bore under County Road 85, located in Homer Township, Section No. 6, 5 and 11, Morgan County, Ohio for a one inch diameter telephone line. Construction of this project will begin on or about August 3, 2009 and will be completed by October 3, 2009. Permission granted upon approval by the Morgan County Engineer.

Becky Thompson, Dog Warden, reported traveling 327.7 miles responding to dog calls. Mrs. Thompson stated S.P.O.T. took 7 dogs, 10 dogs were euthanized, and 13 dogs were impounded.

Kendra Kuntz, Owner/Operator, Imagination Station, addressed questions she had regarding her child care contract relating to the article that was in the Herald. Employees of the Imagination Station and parents/grandparents of some children who attend the Imagination Station were also in attendance. Mrs. Kuntz stated she opened the Imagination Station in 2006, after operating out of her home for 2 years. She employs ten (including her), 60 children are enrolled, and they focus on preparing children for kindergarten: providing meals and a safe environment while the children's parents/guardians are at work. Alyssa Dillaha, Stay-N-Play, attended the Commissioner's meeting. Commissioner Reed explained to Kendra and Alyssa, the Commissioners have no intentions of voiding child care contracts, will look into every complaint, but the Board wants clarification on their options if improprieties are found. Alyssa addressed her feelings regarding the two child care providers. Commissioners thanked Kendra and Alyssa for the services they provide for the county. Kendra thanked the Commissioners for their time and clarification to the article that was in the Herald.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services, submitted meeting requests for Ginger Bowen and DeeAnn Vandine to “Columbus District Child Support”, on August 25th, at Fairfield County JFS; Vicki Quesinberry to “Canton District Meeting”, on August 11th, in Canton. Ms. Quesinberry submitted the 2009 August Mandated Share in the amount of \$5800.83.

Commissioners participated in a conference call with Ms. Collins. Commissioners explained that the Morgan County Humane Society solicited donations for the purchase of the truck for the Dog Wardens use. The former Dog Warden was also a member of the Humane Society. After Tammy Ray's resignation as Dog Warden, the Humane Society withdrew the use of the truck from the county. In return, the Commissioners withdrew the contract for the use of the Dog Pound with the Humane Society. Ms. Collins questioned if anything can be done about this. The Commissioners stated nothing can be done because the truck is titled to the Humane Society not the County. Ms. Collins stated she feels Becky is doing a great job.

Commissioners discussed the public viewing of an alley located in the town of Rosefarm (formerly Rosedale) in York Township scheduled for August 10th, at 11:00am, with Jeff McInturf, Engineer's Office.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, stated she met with the Mayor and council members of Stockport, Lee Conkle, Engineer, L-Con Engineering, to discuss the Public Works application. Stockport has several needs including: sewer line and street paving.
