

**MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, August 31, 2009 with the following members present:

Dean Cain, President  
Don Reynolds, Vice-President  
Mike Reed, Member

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. The minutes of the August 24, 2009 meeting were read and approved.

**09-408** Motion by Mr. Dean Cain and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from August 24, 2009.

**Vote Don Reynolds- yea, Mike Reed- yea, Dean Cain- yea. Motion Carried**

Becky Thompson, Dog Warden, reported traveling 233.4 miles responding to dog calls. Mrs. Thompson stated 13 dogs were picked up and 1 dog was dropped off at pound.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services, submitted meeting request for herself for "Advisory Committee for Adult Tech. Training, on September 17<sup>th</sup>, in Marietta.

A request was submitted by Embarq Telephone, to bore under County Road 70, located in Malta Township, Morgan County, Ohio, for a 1 inch diameter telephone line. Construction of this project will begin on or about September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2009 and will be completed by sixty days. Permission granted upon approval by the Morgan County Engineer.

A request was submitted by Keito Gas Inc., to bore under County Road 14, located in Homer Township, Section No. 3, Morgan County, Ohio, for a 1 inch diameter gas line. Construction of this project will begin on or about as soon as permit is approved and will be completed one week after commencement. Permission granted upon approval by the Morgan County Engineer.

Gary Woodward, Auditor, discussed Transit's budget, Southeastern Ohio Regional Joint Jail bill, one month rent owed to the American Legion for space occupied by Veterans Service Office. Mr. Woodward informed Commissioners 2 persons need to be appointed the Tax Incentive Review Council.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, discussed purchasing fair passes for Transit employees. Commissioners stated they felt it was a good gesture and they do not have a problem with it. Mrs. Wells discussed the Pennsville Formula Project. Pennsville does not have any other replacement projects. Mrs. Wells noted radios will be purchased for Transit drivers and updated Commissioners on the Septic System Projects. A discussion was held concerning Transit's budget. Mrs. Wells requested Commissioners extend Transit's line of credit with Citizens National Bank in the amount of \$50,000.00. A discussion was held concerning Transit participating in ODOT Cooperative Purchasing Program and a resolution authorizing the submittal of (a) proposal(s) with the Ohio Department of Transportation for grants through the US DOT Federal Transit Administration (FTA).

**Authorizing Participation in  
ODOT Cooperative Purchasing Program**

WHEREAS, Section 5513.01 (B) provides the opportunity for State Universities or Colleges, counties, townships, municipal corporations, conservancy districts, township park districts, park districts created under Chapter 1545 ORC, port authorities, regional transit authorities, and county transit boards and local boards of mental retardation and developmental disabilities to participate in contracts of the Ohio Department of Transportation for the purchase of machinery, materials, supplies, or other articles;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Morgan County Commissioners:

Section 1. That the President of Morgan County Commissioners hereby requests authority in the name of Morgan County Commissioners to participate in the Ohio Department of Transportation contracts for the purchase of machinery, materials, supplies, or other articles which the Department has entered into pursuant to Revised Code Section 5513.01 (B).

Section 2. That the President of Morgan County Commissioners is hereby authorized to agree in the name of Morgan County Commissioners to be bound by all terms and conditions as the Director of Transportation prescribes.

Section 3. That the President of Morgan County Commissioners is hereby authorized to agree in the name of Morgan County Commissioners to directly pay the vendor, under each such contract of the Ohio Department of Transportation in which Morgan County Commissioners participates, for items it receives pursuant to the contract.

Section 4. That Morgan County Commissioners agrees to hold the Director of Transportation and the Ohio Department of Transportation harmless for any claim or dispute arising out of participation in a contract pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5513.01 (B).

A resolution authorizing the submittal of (a) proposal(s) with the Ohio Department of Transportation for grants through the US DOT Federal Transit Administration (FTA), as authorized under Federal Transit Laws, as codified, 49 USC Section 5311, Financial Assistance for other than urbanized areas and funds available from the Ohio Public Transportation Grant Program and executing a contract with the Ohio Department of Transportation upon grant proposal acceptance.

WHEREAS, the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation is authorized to make grants for a public transportation program;

WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the proposer, including the provision by it of the local share of the project costs in the program;

WHEREAS, it is required by the U.S. Department of Transportation in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, that in connection with the filing of a proposal for assistance under 49 USC Section 5311 the proposer give an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the U.S. Department of Transportation requirements thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Proposer that disadvantaged business enterprise be used to the fullest extent possible in connection with this/these project(s), and that definite procedures shall be established and administered to ensure that disadvantaged businesses shall have the maximum construction contracts, supplies, equipment contracts, or consultant and other services.

1.   2. The PRESIDENT is authorized to execute and file with such proposal and assurance or any other document required by the U.S. Department of Transportation effectuating the purposes of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
  3. The PRESIDENT is authorized to furnish such additional information as the Ohio Department of Transportation may require in connection with the proposal for the program of projects submitted to FTA.
  4. The PRESIDENT is authorized to set forth and execute affirmative disadvantaged business policies in connection to any procurement made as part of the project.
  5. The PRESIDENT is authorized to execute grant agreements on behalf of MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS with the Ohio Department of Transportation for aid in the financing of operating and capital assistance projects.

Linda Sheets, Office on Aging, discussed the Senior Citizens tax levy and her office's budget.

**09-414** Motion by Mr. Mike Reed and seconded by Mr. Dean Cain to amend resolution 09-390:

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the county commissioners that the amount of tax within the mill limitations of levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide the necessary requirements of the Morgan County Office on Aging in Morgan County, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that in accordance with the provision of O.R. C. Section 5705.19 the Board of County Commissioners of Morgan County hereby declare it necessary to levy a tax in excess of such limitations for the purpose of providing for continuation of services to Senior Citizens through the Morgan County Office on Aging.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such renewal levy shall be at a rate not exceeding 3/10<sup>th</sup> (0.3) of one mill for each one dollar (\$1.00) of tax evaluation which amounts to three cents for each one hundred dollars (\$100) of tax evaluation for a period of five (5) years commencing tax year 2010.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Elections of Morgan County, Ohio be and is hereby directed to submit the issue of the renewal tax levy to the electors of Morgan County at the general election to be held on November 3, 2009, said date being the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November.

Stevan Hook, Engineer, stated the jobs from the stimulus package for bridge painting are done.

Della Bratton telephoned Commissioners to discuss obtaining names to members of the Board of Corporations for businesses that obtain State or Federal money. Ms. Bratton informed Commissioners any business that receives a grant or a loan from the State should have a Board of Corporations. Ms. Bratton requests the contact information for any Board of Corporations be kept in the County's Grant Office. Commissioner Reed stated the county doesn't have ownership to the business who receives grant money. The money comes from the State through the County to the business. The county does not have any say on how they run their businesses. Ms. Bratton declared the businesses owe the county respect.

Bob First, Buckeye Hills RC&D, introduced T.J. Knowlton, whom is working for Buckeye Hills RC&D for his college internship. Mr. First updated Commissioners on the Revolving Loan Fund that the Council has and a variety of other projects.

Doug Matheney thanked Commissioners for letter.

Jim Greer, Greer Insurance, Melinda Jeffers and Victoria Murray, Medical Mutual of Ohio, discussed the county's health insurance.

Those in attendance were: Mr. Steve Hook, Engineer, Mr. John Wells, Mayor, McConnelsville, Mr. Dean Cain, President, Morgan County Commissioners, Mr. Don Reynolds, Vice-President, Morgan County Commissioners, Mr. Mike Reed, Member, Morgan County Commissioners, Ms. Andrea Plummer, Clerk, Morgan County Commissioners, Bill Greuey, Malta Township, John McCort, Pat and Tom Reynolds.

The committee is a 5 member group from the following government entities: 1 member from the Commissioners' office, 1 member from the Mayor's office, 1 member from the Township Trustees', 1 member from the County Engineer's office, and the 5<sup>th</sup> member to be chosen by the other four to represent the general public.

The Mayor's will appoint their representative and their alternate to represent the Mayor's office on the County Sub-Committee at a later date.

The County Engineer's office appointed Mr. Steve Hook as their representative and Mr. Jeff McInturf as the alternate to represent the Engineers' office on the County Sub-Committee.

The Township Trustees appointed Bill Greuey as their representative and Darel Kuntz as their alternate to represent the Township Trustees on the County Sub-Committee.

The 5<sup>th</sup> member will be chosen by the other four members, to represent the general public. John McCort was nominated and will represent the general public.
