

**MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
RIECKER BUILDING**

The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, September 14, 2009 with the following members present:

Dean Cain, President
Don Reynolds, Vice-President
Mike Reed, Member

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. The minutes of the September 8, 2009 meeting were read and approved.

09-431 Motion by Mr. Dean Cain and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from September 8, 2009.

Vote Don Reynolds- yea, Mike Reed- yea, Dean Cain- yea. Motion Carried

Becky Thompson, Dog Warden, reported traveling 95.5 miles responding to dog calls. Mrs. Thompson stated 1 dog was picked up and zero dogs were euthanized.

Gary Woodward, Auditor, submitted the 2010 Commissioner Departmental budgets for Commissioners to fill out.

Gary Woodward, Auditor, Becky Foster, Treasurer, and Peggy Barnes, Recorder, discussed the de-appropriations for the General Fund offices. Mr. Woodward reminded Commissioners as of July 1st, 2009 they have been over appropriated. Mr. Woodward questioned how many de-appropriations were turned in. Commissioners stated officially none were turned in by the Thursday, noon, deadline. The Auditor, Recorder and Treasurer's offices were cut more than 4% like the other offices. Mr. Woodward stated the Auditor, Recorder and Treasurer's office has always complied and worked with the Commissioners now and in the past. Commissioner Reed stated it's up to the officeholders to decide where to cut the de-appropriation. The County will be out of money December 1st if the offices don't make the cuts, Mike Reed explained. Mrs. Foster stated she can't cut anymore. Mrs. Barnes stated her office can't make it through the end of the year. Commissioner Cain recognizes these offices have bent over backwards for Commissioners. The Commissioners previously ordered the County to be closed on Fridays. That order has not been followed by all offices. Offices within the Courthouse have remained open. The purpose of the County closing on Fridays was to help the county reduce the shortfall within the General Fund. Mr. Woodward stated he shut his office down as ordered by the Commissioners on Friday's even though only one of his employees is paid out of the General Fund. He complied with the order. Commissioner Reed stated he doesn't know what to do. Mr. Woodward noted the Commissioners need to force the other General Fund offices to comply. Commissioner Cain inquired on what the Commissioner can do. Commissioner Reed noted everyone in the county needs to know what the Commissioners are trying to do to make cuts. Mrs. Barnes stated we've given up everything and already took two cuts. Mrs. Foster expressed the employees are going to leave next. Mr. Woodward informed Commissioners Transit is \$20,000 in the red. Commissioner Reed replied Transit has \$30,000 coming in this week. Mr. Woodward stated Transit needs the funds today. Commissioner Cain stated he would contact Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development office, and discuss the issue with her and instructed Mr. Woodward to not pay anything out of an account if appropriations have run out.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, and Gary Woodward discussed Transit being in the red. Commissioner Cain informed Shannon from now on if there are no appropriations John Sampson, Transportation Supervisor, is going to have to shut Transit down. Mrs. Wells replied she was requesting \$50,000 from the Line of Credit with Citizens National Bank today.

Gary Woodward, Auditor, inquired on the Board of Elections. Commissioner Reed stated the Board of Elections did not have to de-appropriate. Approximately \$20,000 was added to their budget in order to fund the election. Mr. Woodward questioned if the Board of Elections employees continue to work 25 hours per week. Commissioners stated yes. A discussion was held concerning the county employees having a furlough next year. Commissioner Reed suggested 10 furlough days for full time employees and 5 furlough days for part time employees. Commissioners will discuss this more in depth as this year progresses. Commissioner Cain stated this is better than cutting a position.

Bill Sheppard thanked the Commissioners for the large golf carts provided by Transit for the Morgan County Fair. Mr. Sheppard would like to see the Transit drivers volunteer their time instead of receiving pay while driving the carts at the fair. Mr. Sheppard informed the Commissioners the Senior Club consist of all volunteers.

Ann Combs, Secrest Auditorium, and Janis McFerren, Mid East Career Center, discussed the Public Safety Awareness Day set for October 17th, in Zanesville, at Secrest Auditorium. Three individuals from Morgan County will be receiving awards: one Peace Officer, EMT, and a Firefighter. Ms. Combs and Ms. McFerren stated they are posting signs today throughout to inform the public of the event.

09-432 Motion by Mr. Mike Reed and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the following:

WHEREAS, the citizens of Morgan County appreciate all Public Safety Providers, as they work with great dedication to preserve and protect the integrity of life in our community, therefore we join to declare October 17, 2009 as Public Safety Awareness Day. Judge Favreau, Common Pleas, discussed the 4% de-appropriation with Commissioners. The Judge stated he cannot do it. Judge Favreau stated the case load is 2 months ahead compared to last year. Commissioner Cain stated there were 3 offices in this morning to discuss the de-appropriations. Commissioner Reed explained that those 3 offices are being cut 6.77%. Other offices are being cut 4%. Judge Favreau stated he doesn't know what to do, but he cannot shut the court room down. There is a murder trial coming up. Judge Favreau explained no more cases have been scheduled on Fridays and his employees have brought in \$4000.00 from old court costs. Commissioner Cain stated he doesn't know how we are going to continue to pay people if we don't have the money. Judge Favreau projects his office can generate enough money to keep his office open and he has to have money to have trials. Commissioner Reed stated he doesn't know what the answers are and we are just doing the best with what we have. Judge Favreau inquired on publicizing the levy for the county and let it be known how the county needs it. Commissioners confirmed little publicizing has been done thus far.

Commissioners attended a Public Viewing for the establishment (extension) of Township Road 328 (Tip Lane) set for 11:00am.

A Public Hearing was held in the Commissioners office for the establishment (extension) of Township Road 328 (Tip Lane), at 1:30pm. Those in attendance were: Commissioner Cain, Commissioner Reynolds, Commissioner Reed, and Andrea Plummer, Commissioner's Clerk. With no objections, Commissioners passed the following resolution.

09-433 Motion by Mr. Don Reynolds and seconded by Mr. Mike Reed to approve the establishment (extension) of Township Road 328 (Tip Lane). Township Road 328 (Tip Lane) is located in Section 27 of Center Township. Beginning at the present day west end of Township Road 328 (Tip Lane), said centerline point is 0.38 mile south and west along Township Road 328 from its intersection with Township Road 242 (Stoney Run Road), thence from this starting point along the center of existing maintained road in a southwesterly course (approximately South 50 deg. West) 0.05 mile to a point, thence continuing along the centerline of existing maintained road in a northerly course (approximately North 20 deg. East) 0.17 mile to Newton's Cemetery and the terminus of this extension. It is intended to extend Township Road 328 (Tip Lane) by 0.22 mile to Newton's Cemetery.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, informed Commissioners Transit is no longer in the red. She received the \$50,000 Line of Credit. Mrs. Wells informed Commissioners the Development Office would be closed Thursday, in order to attend a mandatory meeting with Ohio Department of Transportation for Transit. Mrs. Wells noted Transit will be ordering a new vehicle. This is being funded by stimulus dollars.

**A RESOLUTION urging the United States Senate to not pass
S. 1462 “The American Clean Energy Leadership Act.”**

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Morgan County supports our local economy; and

WHEREAS, Ohio utilizes coal as its primary energy source; and

WHEREAS, without coal as our primary energy source, electricity rates would soar; and

WHEREAS, with increased rates, many businesses would not be able to afford to stay in business; and

WHEREAS, Morgan County’s families would be negatively affected by any Renewable Energy Standard or Cap and Trade Legislation; and

Resolved, That the Morgan County Commissioners

1. Politely requests that any renewable energy standard or cap and trade legislation be voted against in the best interest of our community; and
2. Passage of such legislation would continue to hurt our counties families and businesses while increasing unemployment and lowering our tax revenue.

Gary Miller, Central Ohio Coal Company, met with Commissioners to discuss County Road 11. Also in attendance were: David Hooper, Jeff Howell, Rick Demster, W. Wallace, Donald Webb, Mike McGee, and C. B. McCormick. Commissioner Reed informed Mr. Miller of the Commissioners decision on September 8th, 2009, concerning County Road 11, which was to extend the temporary closure of County Road 11 through September 30, 2010 with failure to meet Engineer approval that the road meets minimum state requirements there will be a fine implemented in the amount of \$200.00 per day until the road is opened. Mr. Miller stated there is still work to be done out there in 2011-2012. There is still a workforce out there. Currently there are 19 people working out there and safety is an issue not only for the employees but also the public. Mr. Miller made a request to extend the temporary closure of County Road 11 for 18 months and open on July 1st, 2011. The ditches will be established and opened and Central Ohio Coal will maintain the road for one year. Mr. Miller offered to purchase additional stone for Meigsville Township provided the Commissioners granted an extended temporary closure beyond the 18 months. Mr. Howell addressed Mr. Miller and his offer of additional stone to Meigsville and questioned the safety concern. Mr. Hooper stated the mine is still considered an active mine area.

Central Ohio Coal Company still has obligations to the State of Ohio. Mr. Howell stated the road belongs to the taxpayers and the road needs to be opened because if Unionville floods there is no way out. Commissioners passed the following resolutions.

Elaine Flesher, Health Department, provided Commissioners with an update on N1H1. This virus is combination of human, bird and swine flu. Ms. Flesher stated a PowerPoint presentation has been constructed and will be presented to the school system to teachers and faculty. People need to take preventative measures and use antibacterial soap. A vaccine has not been approved by the Federal Drug Administration, but Mrs. Flesher believes the vaccine will be made available soon and will possibly be available in October. It is believed there will be one shot required for adults and two shots for children.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, opened a quote for the Senior Center's Community Development Block Grant project. One quote was received from Kings Future Builders in the amount of \$5,100.
