# MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS RIECKER BUILDING

The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, December 7, 2009 with the following members present:

Dean Cain, President Don Reynolds, Vice-President Mike Reed, Member

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. The minutes of the November 30, 2009 meeting were read and approved.

**09-577** Motion by Mr. Dean Cain and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from November 30, 2009.

### Vote Don Reynolds- yea, Mike Reed- yea, Dean Cain- yea. Motion Carried

Commissioners are in receipt of the Morgan County Jail usage for the month of November 2009 to reduce costs at the Southeastern Ohio Regional Joint Jail. The total bed days for month of August were 125. This count is prisoners held here for at least one day each and other prisoners were also brought for court and returned are in addition to these figures.

Commissioners are in receipt of a Certificate of County Auditor that the Total Appropriations from each Fund, The General and Public Assistance, **Do** Exceed the Last Amended Official Estimate of Resources for the Fiscal Year Beginning January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009.

Becky Thompson, Dog Warden, reported traveling 133.7 miles responding to dog calls. Mrs. Thompson stated six dogs were put in the pound and eight dogs were euthanized. Mrs. Thompson informed the Commissioners the satellite offices that will be selling dog tags are: Jumper's Corner located in Reinersville, S&S Carry Out located in Deavertown, and The Station located in Chesterhill.

Cassidy McGrew, Deputy Dog Warden, reported traveling 81.3 miles responding to dog calls.

Commissioner Cain informed the other Commissioners he spoke with Deana Clark, CVB, and noted 1300 tickets were sold for the Christmas in the Village this past weekend. Over 1000 actually made purchases within the village. Commissioner Reed stated he was happy to see a Muskingum Charter Bus in the county; individuals shopped and went to the Opera House. Commissioners stated Christmas in the Village was a huge success.

David Bailey stated the as of December 6, 2009 there have been 5,621 E-911 calls have been processed, mapped, tracked and documented by four electronic servers. A new Plant/CML 911 system was placed in service by Plant/CML and Embarq Engineer and Technicians under the direction of the Morgan County 911 Director. The Morgan County 911 plan was rewritten and upgraded to an Enhanced 911 plan which included mapping and receiving wireless calls with mapped location if the cellular telephone contains a GPS receiver and the GPS function is turned on the cellular telephone. By the County 911 director rewriting the Morgan County Plan and making a grant application through the

Public Utility Commission of Ohio (PUCO), Morgan County obtained a grant for Phase II wireless location compliance and future E-911 system, dispatch equipment upgrades and other potential upgrades which could include future Computer Assisted Dispatch (CAD). Some of the work in progress is: continued public education with respect to the new Morgan County E-911 system and the need for an accurate address number, specific full proper road name, and proper township location in the data base; educate public their cell phone GPS must be turned on for 911 to receive a location; educate the public the wireless system does an automatic rebid of location every 15-25 seconds; educate the public the GPS may not receive a satellite signal inside a building or automobile. Mr. Bailey submits a quarterly report to the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio. All systems have operated flawlessly since their installation in Mid-March of 2009. Mr. Bailey asked the Commissioners to authorize a payment of the one-time non-recurring service fee for Wireless Phase II compliance. The amount is \$3500.00 payable to Untied Telephone Company of Ohio in Mansfield, as outlined in the agreement, also to authorize payment of the monthly recurring service fee for Wireless Phase II compliance. The monthly amount of the E-911 Wireless Phase II compliance service fees is \$250.00. Both of these items are covered and payment authorized in the PUCO grant.

WHEREAS, Morgan County is situated within the geographic boundaries of the Southeastern Ohio Joint Solid Waste Management District (the District); and

WHEREAS, The Policy Committee for the District adopted a draft Solid Waste Management Plan on November 17, 2009, for the fifteen-year period beginning in 2010 and ending in 2024; and

WHEREAS, the draft Solid Waste Management Plan for the District was submitted to this Board (Council) for its review in accordance with the requirements of Chapters 343 and 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code;

NOW AND THEREFORE, be it resolved that the draft Solid Waste Management Plan for the Southeastern Ohio Joint Solid Waste Management District is hereby ratified; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be mailed by the Clerk of this Board (Council) to the District Coordinator at the District's offices in Caldwell, Ohio.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services, submitted meeting requests for Jody Murray to Athens, on December 10<sup>th</sup>, to attend a "Children with Special Healthcare Needs" meeting; DeeAnn Vandine to Hartville, Ohio, on December 14<sup>th</sup>, to attend a "CSEA Association" meeting.

An individual asked Commissioners if they have any control over the Morgan Meigs Water Board. Commissioners stated they do not. The individual expressed his unhappiness with the Morgan Meigs Water Board and declared the Commissioners should take it over

Bailey Wilson, Louise Pennock, Mary Anna Wallace, and Azcal Wilson, Board of Elections, discussed the Board's requested 2010 budget in the amount of \$142,199.52. Commissioner Reed addressed the Board and informed them the General Fund Budget for 2010 is down another \$109,000 from last year. As the Commissioners have been working on the budget, each department will be cut a minimum of 7.5%. The Board of Election's budget is not going to be cut for the 2010 budget. In 2008 the Board of Elections was appropriated \$60,000; in 2009 they were appropriated \$57,500 (which was not enough to run the office). The Commissioners appropriated additional funds throughout the year which gave them a final budget amount consisting of \$86,770.42. Commissioner Reed stated their 2010 budget would be \$92,000-\$93,000. Mrs. Pennock stated the Commissioners are cutting their budget. Commissioners stated they can not give the Board what they requested, which was the \$142,199.52. They simply don't have the money. The Board of Elections is unhappy with the Commissioners decision and stated they will do what they have to do. Commissioner Reed declared that funds will not be allocated to non-mandated programs such as: Soil and Water and EMA. The county has to make all the cuts necessary to balance the budget. A discussion was held concerning the Board of Elections pay rate for a new Director and Clerk; \$15-\$16 per hour. Commissioners expressed the new employees could be hired at a lower rate. Bailey Wilson stated the last election was run by Louise, Mary Anna, and Azcal. Commissioners informed the Board the ladies did a super job.

Commissioners discussed the measurement of a right a way and the Planning Commission regulations with Jeff McInturf, Engineer's Office.

Miranda Mullen, EMA, informed Commissioners she has been working with Elaine Flesher, Health Department, on a grant from the Ohio Hospital Association to purchase a BlueMed vehicle. This vehicle is a 25 bed facility that would be paid 100% with grant dollars to use as a triage in the event of a mass emergency. The vehicle costs \$172,669.00 and is twenty-seven feet long. The EMA would be responsible for the cost of insurance; quoted \$800.00 year; 50% would be reimbursed by . Ms. Mullen stated she's been working with Ms. Flesher to staff the vehicle with Medical Reserve Core individuals.

Commissioners informed Shannon they would like time to discuss all options. Mrs. Wells discussed the tire bids received for tires for Transit, as well as Transit's budget. Properties were discussed that could be demolished for the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP).
