

**MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
RIECKER BUILDING**

The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, December 21, 2009 with the following members present:

Dean Cain, President  
Don Reynolds, Vice-President  
Mike Reed, Member

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. The minutes of the December 14, 2009 meeting were read and approved.

**09-607** Motion by Mr. Dean Cain and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from December 14, 2009.

Becky Thompson, Dog Warden, reported traveling 129.7 miles responding to dog calls. Mrs. Thompson stated three dogs were picked up, three dogs went to S.P.O.T., one dog was sold, and one dog was redeemed.

Judge Favreau, Common Pleas, submitted a contract to be signed by Commissioner Cain.

Tom Jenkins, Sr., Sheriff, Gary Woodward, Auditor, Mark Howdyshell, Prosecutor, Peggy Barnes, Recorder, and Beckie Foster, Treasurer, discussed the shortfall within their 2010 appropriations. Mr. Howdyshell inquired if the 4-D contract with CSEA was included in his appropriation of \$153,890.10. Commissioners stated the appropriation did include the 4-D contract. Mark declared last year the Prosecutor's Office was appropriated \$145,000.00 and the Commissioners rolled over an additional \$25,000.00 into the Prosecutor's budget from the Joint Jail line item in order for the Prosecutor's Office to carry out the 4-D contract. Mr. Howdyshell acknowledged his salary and two secretaries' salaries exceed the 2010 appropriation. That also leaves no money for supplies. Commissioner Reed stated the Commissioners would love to give the elected officials what they want but there is none to give. Each General Fund County Office was cut between 7.5% - 10%. Commissioners were asked if the courts took a cut in their appropriation. Commissioners replied the courts did take a cut, but their 2010 line item budget amounts have not been submitted yet. Mr. Woodward stated his employees are working over and only being paid eight hours. Sheriff Jenkins exclaimed he's unhappy with his appropriation and on December 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2009 the jail will close and will remain closed until further notice. The Sheriff stated he's saved the county \$86,000.00 by housing the inmates at the jail instead of sending them to the Southeastern Ohio Regional Joint Jail. The Sheriff has worked a lot to keep jail open, but he's not doing it this year (2010). Commissioners don't pay for soap, blankets, etc. This has been coming out of the Sheriff's budget. The Sheriff and Beckie Foster, Treasurer, request next year, the Commissioners don't send the appropriation through email; rather be told face to face. Mrs. Foster stated her office is cut continually. Her appropriation for her office will not cover her salary and a part

time deputy. Sheriff Jenkins asked if in the middle of next year we have extra monies come in will his office get it. Commissioner Reed noted if more money comes available mid next year; it will be divided equally among the departments based on percentages. Mrs. Foster inquired where they see money coming in from. Commissioners stated they don't foresee any additional money coming in.

Commissioners are in receipt of a letter from Sheriff Jenkins, Sr., stating due to budget cuts at the Morgan County Sheriff's Office, the Morgan County Twelve Day Jail will be closed to inmates by December 23, 2009, and will remain closed to inmates until further notice.

Jeanne Wilson, Senior Appalachian Regional Representative, Senator Sherrod Brown, inquired on potential projects in Morgan County that the Commissioners don't have money for. The 2<sup>nd</sup> week of February is the deadline for appropriates. The form that needs to be filled out is located on the Senator's website and needs to be filed electronically. Ms. Wilson inquired if Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, would be submitting the form. Commissioners agreed that Mrs. Wells will submit the form. Jeanne stated almost \$400,000 was given to Noble County. Commissioner Cain discussed the 209 project for a new Industrial Park and a new jail for the county. The jail needs expanded. The current jail is only a five bed facility and females cannot be housed there. Commissioner Reed stated they would like to increase it to a twenty-five bed facility. The savings from housing inmates in the county jail instead of the Southeastern Ohio Regional Joint Jail would pay for the wages for several new employees. Ms. Wilson stated she will meet with Mrs. Wells to discuss these projects and the procedures to filling out the form.

Stevan Hook, Engineer, requested permission to purchase an asphalt grinder, free water system, in the amount of \$104,950 from State bid.

Miranda Mullen, EMA/OHS, plead with Commissioners to reconsider funding the EMA. Commissioner Cain stated they simply do not have the money. All non-mandated programs are not being funded. Commissioner Reed questioned the amount of \$5000.00 that the EMA has been appropriated in the past. Ms. Mullen stated the 18 subdivisions contribute a total of \$5000.00 and the county matched the amount; without funding from the county, the EMA will not qualify for some grant programs. One of the programs is a reimbursement program for money spent on a federal declared disaster. 75% comes back from the federal government and 12.5% comes back from the state. Ms. Mullen stated if the county does not appropriate funds to the EMA, she will have no choice but to lay off Terry Robison. Ms. Mullen informed Commissioners that Terry Robison will resign as Chairman for LEPC; January 1, 2010. Miranda stated she was interested in the position. This is a volunteer position.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, informed Commissioners she attended the Housing Advisory Committee meeting last week. A discussion was held concerning two grants offered through Community Action. One grant is a \$15,000 grant, RHISCO, for a single parent family. Participants must be willing to undergo counseling. The second a three year program in the amount of \$355,000, Homeless Prevention Rapid Re-housing, helps keep individuals in their home (maximum of 18 months). A case worker is in Morgan County once a week.

Nick Gatz, Representative from Senator Voinovich's Southeast Office, asked Commissioners what projects they might have in mind for potential funding. Commissioner Cain informed Nick of the 209 project for a new Industrial Park and a new jail for the county. Commissioners would like to see the jail expanded into a 25 bed facility and have the capability to house females. Mr. Gatz questioned the availability of water/sewer in the county. Commissioner Cain stated water is a huge issue in the county; one mile to two miles out of villages there is no water or sewer. Nick inquired on the availability of broadband

throughout the county. Commissioner Reed noted a gentleman from Connect Ohio was holding meetings in the county to discuss broadband but the stimulus money fell through. Commissioner Reed questioned why don't PUCO mandate local providers to provide access to 100% capacity within five years. Nick asked about Engineer projects. Commissioners discussed the 37/78 Corridor; all studies are done. Commissioner Cain noted this would really change this section of south east Ohio. This is on the Ohio Department of Transportation's twenty year plan.

Dawn Rauch, Washington-Morgan Community Action, discussed the Housing Revolving Loan Fund Agreement. A discussion was also held concerning four properties that will be tore down for the Neighborhood Stabilization Program. There is an issue with one property; permission was given by an individual who is legally not the property owner. Letters were sent out to all four property owners. Ms. Rauch stated more properties are going to be able to be torn down.
