The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, March 15, 2010 with the following members present:

Don Reynolds, Vice-President  
Dean Cain, Member

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.  
The minutes of the March 8, 2010 meeting were read and approved.

**10-123** Motion by Mr. Mike Reed and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from March 8, 2010.

**Vote Don Reynolds- yea, Mike Reed- yea, Dean Cain- yea. Motion Carried**

Becky Thompson, Dog Warden, reported traveling 242.5 miles responding to dog calls. Mrs. Thompson stated 18 dogs were impounded, 2 dogs were euthanized, 1 dog was sold, and SPOT took 20 dogs.

Blythe Schubert, Kate Love Simpson Library, affirmed the library received 13 computers from Connect Ohio. Blythe invited the Commissioners to a Potluck Dinner on May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 6-9pm, and encouraged them to stopover and observe the difference Connect Ohio has made to the library. A discussion was held concerning ABLE program and applying for a grant in the amount of \$1500.00 for adult literacy materials.

A discussion was held with Gary Woodward, Auditor, concerning Transit's \$100,000 note being default and a \$5000.00 late charge. Commissioners will address this issue with Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office.

Pam Montgomery, OSU Extension, updated on Agricultural and Natural Resources: April 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>, Advanced Grazing School will be held at the High School Vo-Ag room; April 5<sup>th</sup> Morgan County Cattleman's Association will meet at 7pm, at the High School Vo-Ag room; April 23<sup>rd</sup> the Farmer's Market will start up; the Master Gardener's are working on the Community Garden project and the summer garden tour, as well as, their community maintenance projects at the library and Malta Park. Twenty-one new volunteer packets have been mailed or handed out to potential new 4-H Advisors in 2010. Ohio Volunteer Conference was held for March 13<sup>th</sup> in Columbus, Ohio. Six volunteers attended the conference. 4-H clubs have been forming for 2010 since January. Parents or youth can call the Extension Office at 740-962-4854 to identify the clubs in their area. Enrollment deadline is April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010. 4-H Open House was held on March 4<sup>th</sup> from 4:30-8:00pm at the Extension Office. Approximately 15 different families visited the Extension Office to learn more about 4-H Youth Development in Morgan County and 4-H Theatre Arts program, and the Morgan County 4-H Shooting Sports Program. Individuals needing to schedule for the programs: Helping Children Cope with Divorce and Co-Parenting for Never Married Co-Parents programs can call the Extension Office to register. Helping Children Cop with Divorce starts March 29<sup>th</sup> and Co-Parenting for Never Married Co-Parents starts April 15<sup>th</sup>. Dining with Diabetes for 2010 is: September 30<sup>th</sup>, October 7<sup>th</sup>, and October 14<sup>th</sup>. Time and location will be announced at a later date. An update was provided for Family Nutrition Program: Elaine Lindimore, Family Nutrition Program Educator has a total of 17 programs scheduled between March 15<sup>th</sup> and April 17<sup>th</sup>. Pam mentioned Amy Grove is working on GOBA;

food, entertainment, shuttle service and activities at the fairground. She will be working with the downtown businesses to prepare them for the people and ways to make riders feel welcome in the community. Amy is a member of the Convention and Visitors Bureau and they will be choosing a brand/tagline and logo. Amy Grove, Chris Penrose and Pam Montgomery will be involved with the Department of Job and Family Services Reality Store at the High School March 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>. Mrs. Montgomery encouraged the Commissioners to visit the Extension Office and staff to learn more about their programs. The Extension Advisory meeting will be held on April 12<sup>th</sup>, 7-9pm.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Service, submitted meeting requests for Heidi Burns to "Quarterly Fiscal WIA Funding", in Caldwell, on March 18<sup>th</sup>; Vicki Quesinberry and Kim Reed to "Bidders Conference for RFP, Workforce Investment Act Funding", in Caldwell, on March 19<sup>th</sup>. Vicki acknowledged Mahle Corporation donated a 2005 Chevy Venture van to Job and Family Services.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, informed Commissioners as of January 26<sup>th</sup>, 2010 there are 32 homeless people living in Morgan County. Commissioners discussed Transit's Line of Credit with Shannon. Mrs. Wells acknowledged it will be paid today and she hopes to have the late fee waived. Shannon confirmed she will be attending a Revolving Loan Committee meeting this afternoon at 1:00pm. A discussion was held concerning offering ABC Manufacturing to pay an interest only payment. Their payment is now default; they have 6 interest only payments left. Mrs. Wells clued-up the Commissioners, Transit will be moving into the Finley Building on March 24<sup>th</sup>. Shannon requested a copy of the Morgan County contractor list from Washington-Morgan Community Action for CHIP. There was only one Morgan County contractor listed. Mrs. Wells discussed entering into an agreement with Vinton County to aid in the administration of the CHIP program. It was mentioned there is the potential for more stimulus money for the septic system program.

Amber Leasure-Earnhardt, Sunday Creek Watershed, informed the Commissioner they were awarded a Watershed Coordinator Grant from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources in 2009. This three year grant will provide the base salary and fringe benefits for the coordinator positions. A requirement of the grant involves obtaining local matching funds, thereby encouraging local support and investment. The match requirement is \$3500.00 per year. Sunday Creek Watershed Group would appreciate any financial support that the Board of Commissioners could give for 2010. Amber provided an annual update. Sunday Creek Watershed consists of 139 square miles, encompasses parts of Morgan, Perry and Athens Counties. The Stream is 27 miles long. The Sunday Creek Watershed focuses on restoration activities around four major issues: acid mine drainage, improperly treated wastewater, illegal dumping and sedimentation.
