

**MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
RIECKER BUILDING**

The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, April 12, 2010 with the following members present:

Mike Reed, President  
Don Reynolds, Vice-President  
Dean Cain, Member

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.  
The minutes of the April 5, 2010 meeting were read and approved.

**10-156** Motion by Mr. Mike Reed and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from April 5, 2010.

**Vote Don Reynolds- yea, Mike Reed- yea, Dean Cain- yea. Motion Carried**

Becky Thompson, Dog Warden, reported traveling 215.2 miles responding to dog calls. Mrs. Thompson stated 5 dogs were euthanized and 1 dog was taken by S.P.O.T.

Mark Howdyshell, Prosecutor, discussed the county's four enterprise zone agreements; the paperwork was not completed properly. Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, sat in on the conversation. According to the recommendation by the Ohio Department of Development the agreements should be rescinded, but rather remediate the problem. Mark requested Commissioners grant him permission to draft letters to resolve the issues with the enterprise zone agreements; ODOD will approve the letters before they are mailed. Commissioners granted Mark the authority to draft the letters, are grateful for everything Mark is doing to resolve the issues, and are confident in him. Mrs. Wells inquired on recovery zone bonds. Prosecutor Howdyshell educated the Commissioners; every state was granted federal dollars for recovery zone bonds. The state set aside dollars for every county; a bond is a debt. Due to the county's financial situation, the county is not in a position to borrow money. Commissioner Reed stated the state would forgive 45% of the interest but the county is still responsible for the face value of the bond. Commissioners are required to sign a letter confirming the county is not interested in any recovery zone bonds. Mark acknowledged ABC Manufacturing is in default on their payments; an official notice will be sent to the company and encourage them the county will work with them to bring note back in good standing. A discussion was held concerning the Board of Elections printing ballots in their office and entering into a lease option to purchase the equipment from Advanced Ballot Solutions. The estimated cost of the equipment is \$25,000.00 (\$4680 per year for 5 years). Commissioners request to speak with the Board of Elections before they make a decision. Commissioners and Prosecutor Howdyshell discussed the Board of Elections bringing lawsuit against the Morgan County Commissioners to declare the 2010 appropriation to the Board of Elections inadequate and to seek a Court Order for an additional appropriation. The following resolution was passed.

**10-157** Motion by Mr. Dean Cain and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the following:

Whereas, the Morgan County Board of Elections have informed the Morgan County Prosecutor of their intent to bring suit against the Morgan County Commissioners to declare the 2010

appropriation to the Board of Elections inadequate and to seek a Court Order for an additional appropriation in the amount requested by the Board of Elections; and

Whereas, the Prosecuting Attorney is obligated by law to represent both the Board of Commissioners and the Board of Elections; and

Whereas, the Prosecuting Attorney may not legally represent one statutory client against another in an adversarial proceeding; and

Whereas, the Morgan County Prosecuting Attorney has made arrangements for each Board to be represented by special counsel and now seeks authority under Section 305.14 R.C. to petition the Court of common Pleas for appointment of special counsel to represent the Board of Commissioners and the Board of Elections in the litigation anticipated by the Board of Elections against the Board of Commissioners.

Now Therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Morgan County, Ohio, that the Prosecuting Attorney is hereby granted authority to apply to the court of common Pleas of Morgan County, Ohio for an Order granting authority to the Board of Commissioners to employ legal counsel to represent the Board of commissioners and Board of Elections in the litigation anticipated by the Board of Elections. Passed this 12<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2010.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services, submitted the April, 2010 Mandated Share in the amount of \$5775.99. A meeting request was submitted for Kim Reed to turn in RFP at the O.V.E.R. office in Caldwell, on April 12, 2010. Ms. Quesinberry updated Commissioners on visit from Eric Mency and Michael Colbert, Ohio Department of Job and Family Services.

Mr. and Mrs. Tom Reynolds held a conversation with Commissioners and discussed the amount of foreclosure filings in Morgan County and a variety of other items.

Beckie Foster, Treasurer, inquired on a drop box for her office.

Commissioners held a conversation with Gary Woodward, Auditor, regarding EMA's payroll.

Chet McCormick requested a copy of the ambulance contract with M&M and inquired on the specifics with the ambulance levy that is on the May ballot.

Linda Sheets, Office on Aging, submitted invoices.

Peggy Barnes, Recorder, inquired on purchasing a copier for her office. Commissioners granted her permission.

Bernie Kinder, Kinder's Insurance, asked Commissioners if they had any questions/concerns. Commissioners commented on the recent accident with one of Transit's vehicles.

Stevan Hook, Engineer, asked Commissioners if they had any questions/concerns or has received any telephone calls with complaints regarding county roads. Commissioner Cain informed Steve they have received no complaints.

Missy Fisher, Director, Board of Elections, and MaryAnna Wallace, Board of Elections, spoke to Commissioners regarding entering into a lease option to purchase the equipment from Advanced Ballot Solutions to print ballots in their office. Commissioners questioned how they intended to pay for the yearly cost; \$4680 per year for 5 years. Commissioners were informed it would be taken out of their line item.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, declared she received a payment from ABC Manufacturing; March and late payment fee. Mrs. Wells was informed ABC's April payment will be paid by the end of the week. Commissioners acknowledged they will be administering the Family and Children First program and discussed options with Shannon. Mrs. Wells educated Commissioners on the Homeownership Showcase that will be held Tuesday, April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2:00-4:00pm, in the Community Room. Lenders and Realtors will be on hand to answer questions and offer advice on buying your first home. Commissioner Reed informed Shannon on a letter received from the Ohio Department of Development notifying Morgan County being awarded \$89,000 for the 2010 Community Development Block Grant- Formula Allocation. The Development Office will be closed on Wednesday, April 14, 2010, due to training in Reynoldsburg. Shannon discussed Washington-Morgan Community Action bidding five properties together for the Neighborhood Stabilization Program I. Commissioners are not in favor of bidding five properties together; but rather, two properties bid together and by location. Mrs. Wells expressed concern in regards to the new floor being put down at Transit's new facility; buffing and sealing the floor was not included in the quote. Commissioners directed Shannon to ask Decorator's Den how much they would charge to finish the floor.

Dale Hartle, President, Ohio Regional Development Corporation, Julie Smith, Program Director, Ohio Regional Development Corporation, Denny Lowe, Property Specialist, Ohio Regional Development Corporation, and three representatives from Muskingum County's Community Development Office, well-informed Commissioners on the Neighborhood Stabilization Program 2. ORDC was awarded 2.8 million dollars for the NSP 2. ORDC covers the following seven counties: Crawford, Morrow, Coshocton, Guernsey, Belmont, Muskingum and Morgan. The grant period is from April 1, 2010 - February 28, 2013. The following activities will be administered for the grant: demolition/clearance -\$266,000; housing development -\$2,394,000; General Administration -\$231,300. The expenditure of NSP 2 funds are as follows: March 31, 2011 -40% expended; September 20, 2011 -75% expended; December 31, 2011 -90% expended; and January 31, 2013 -100% expended. The project completion dates are as follows: work completed -December 31, 2012; drawdown requests -January 31, 2013; closeout -February 28, 2013. Mr. Hartle provided a packet of information for Commissioners review regarding general information, contact information, eligible activities summary, affordability period, and eligible census tracts for the NSP 2.
