

**MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, May 24, 2010 with the following members present:

Mike Reed, President  
Don Reynolds, Vice-President  
Dean Cain, Member

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.  
The minutes of the May 17, 2010 meeting were read and approved.

**10-211** Motion by Mr. Mike Reed and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from May 17, 2010.

**Vote Don Reynolds- yea, Mike Reed- yea, Dean Cain- yea. Motion Carried**

Becky Thompson, Dog Warden, reported traveling 189.8 miles responding to dog calls. Mrs. Thompson stated 5 dogs were picked up, 4 dogs were euthanized, and 4 dogs were redeemed.

Della Bratton telephoned Commissioners to discuss non-profit organizations and them obtaining a levy. If a non-profit is not legit it is the county's responsibility to go after the organization and retain the taxpayer's money.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services, submitted a certificate of records disposal and a meeting request for herself to "Canton District Directors" meeting in Marietta, on June 1<sup>st</sup>. Vicki made the following statement: The Department of Job and Family Services does not operate using General Fund Revenue. We operate within our budget and draw money from the State after we have expenditures. Auditor Woodward was notified that we would review our situation the first of July and will make any reductions or increase to the amended certificate, as needed, at that time.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, and Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services, held a conversation regarding the contract between Transit and JFS. The two are working on a solution. Shannon spent hours on the phone with a representative from the Ohio Department of Transportation; it was suggested to implement a 10% increase. JFS is currently charged \$25.55 per hour. Shannon remarked Transit needs to work hard and make it more sufficient by scheduling more than one person on a bus when traveling to Columbus. Commissioner Reed expressed the Commissioners are glad they have come to an agreement.

Gary Woodward, Auditor, discussed entering into an agreement with the Local Government Services Section of the Office of the Auditor of State (LGS), to compile the basic financial statements for Morgan County for the year ending December 31, 2009 and December 31, 2010.
