The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, June 21, 2010 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
The minutes of the June 14, 2010 meeting were read and approved.

10-257 Motion by Mr. Mike Reed and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from June 14, 2010.

Becky Thompson, Dog Warden, reported traveling 278.4 miles responding to dog calls. Mrs. Thompson stated 17 dogs were impounded, 1 dog was euthanized, and 2 dogs were redeemed.

Chris Penrose, OSU Extension, informed the Commissioner the deadline for Trophy Sponsorship at this year's fair has been extended to July 6th. Chris updated Commissioners on 4-H Development: Junior Fair Royalty Applications are available from youth organization advisors or at the Extension Office (applications are due by 4:30pm on August 2nd to the Extension Office); 4-H Camp Registration and deposit are due by 4:30pm on July 6th; Cloverbud Day Camp letters have been mailed out to all 4-H Cloverbuds (Registration and camp fee are due by 4:30pm, July 12th); 4-H Project Judging is scheduled for July 13th at East Elementary; Clothing and Textile Judging and Style Revue Awards Night are scheduled for July 15th at the Opera House; 4-H Junior Leaders cleaned the weeds and trash out the flower bed in front of Riecker Building on June 7th; 2010 Camp Counselors enjoyed their training at Camp Hervida on June 4th and 5th; 4-H Junior Leaders are planning a canoe trip on August 14th; Skilathon scheduled (August 19th--Horse and August 21st---Beef, Dairy, Rabbits, Sheep, Swine & Goats, Poultry and Dogs); Any 4-H member or parent with questions regarding upcoming deadlines or events can call their 4-H Advisor or the Extension Office for clarification. The following classes are scheduled for Family and Consumer Sciences: Helping Children Cope with Divorce on August 31st and Co-Parenting for Never Married Co-Parents on September 14th. Individuals interested in registering for one of these classes can call the Extension Office at 740-962-4854. Chris provided the following updates on Agriculture & Natural Resources: Chris completed ATV training to all fourth-sixth graders in the Morgan Local School District, assisted with Hay Day at Belle Valley on June 17th, and taught farm safety at Farm Bureau meeting on June 5th; Master Gardeners have been working on several projects including Embree Park in Pennsville and are planning a Garden Tour in Chesterhill area on June 27th from 1-5pm. Chris conducted several farm visits the past month and is planning the 10th Annual Ag and Livestock Field Day on August 9th. Anyone that has questions or issues regarding agriculture, natural resources, horticulture, lawn or insects should contact Chris at the Extension Office. The Farmer's Market continues each Friday and Chris thanked the Commissioners for having the Commons moved and looking nice. The produce auction has started and sales are up from 2009.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, discussed the FY 2010 Community Development Block Grant Neighborhood Revitalization Grant.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services, submitted the contract between the Morgan County Department of Job and Family Services and Ohio Valley Employment Resource Office for Commissioner's signatures. A discussion was held concerning a letter received from Michael Colbert, Ohio Department of Job and Family Services in regard to repayment of old debt or over-advancements from the late 90's. There are two options to select from: payment in full or installment payment not to exceed ten (10) years. Vicki informed the Commissioners the Mandated Share for State Fiscal Year 2011 has reduced by \$21,007 per year; starting in July 2010 through June 2011.

John Kitts and Pam Morrow, Veteran's Service Office, informed the Commissioners that the Veteran's Office may be out of money before the end of the year due to retirement payouts, but they were working with the State and the Auditor's Office to resolve the issue.

Gary Woodward, Auditor, updated Commissioners on the Southeastern Ohio Regional Joint Jail meeting he had attended this morning. A discussion was held concerning the amount of overage charges for the month of May that consisted of \$16,000. Mr. Woodward estimated at this rate the Jail appropriation would be used up by the end of September.

Jim Greer, Medical Mutual, checked in with the Commissioners.

John Wells, Mayor, Village of McConnelsville, told the Commissioners the Village will be planting more trees in the fall and wanted to know if the Commissioners were interested in two trees in front of the Reicker Building. Commissioner thought it may be a good idea but asked Mayor Wells to check back with them in the fall.

Stevan Hook, Engineer, asked the Commissioners if they had anything for him. Commissioner Reed advised Mr. Hook he had received a call from a lady on County Road 21 (Eppley Road) and she stated how bad of condition the road was in. Mr. Hook replied he would agree with her assessment and that he will be looking into it. Steve informed the Commissioner that his scanner/printer had gone bad and needs replaced. Kay Blueprint Inc. had the State Bid at a price of \$19,700. Steve further explained there would be a \$400 trade-in value on the old one and the new one included set up, delivery, and \$480 of free ink.
