

**MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
RIECKER BUILDING**

The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Tuesday, July 6, 2010 with the following members present:

Mike Reed, President
Don Reynolds, Vice-President
Dean Cain, Member

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
The minutes of the June 28, 2010 meeting were read and approved.

10-275 Motion by Mr. Mike Reed and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from June 28, 2010.

Vote Don Reynolds- yea, Mike Reed- yea, Dean Cain- yea. Motion Carried

Becky Thompson, Dog Warden, reported traveling 145.8 miles responding to dog calls. Mrs. Thompson stated 9 dogs were impounded, 2 dogs were euthanized, 15 dogs were taken by S.P.O.T., and 3 dogs were in the pound.

Ancil King, Jr., Deputy Dog Warden, reported traveling 10 miles assisting the Dog Warden.

Commissioners approved an application from Thelma McGann, to bury a new 50-24 FSF cable along County Road 52, located in Bristol Township, Morgan County, Ohio. The Construction of this project will begin on or about July 12, 2010 and will be completed by August 27, 2010.

DeeAnn Vandine, Job and Family Services, submitted bills.

Gary Woodward, Auditor, informed the Commissioners of an autopsy bill in the amount of \$1100.00 from Franklin County and having no money to pay it. Commissioner Reed inquired if Franklin County would accept installments. Gary stated he would have to check. A discussion was held concerning levies for the Board for Developmental Disabilities.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, informed Commissioners all of the septic systems are in the ground and done, however; there are some issues with Richard Webb's septic. Shannon hopes to have it resolved soon. Mrs. Wells stated the Revolving Loan Fund was monitored by a representative from the Ohio Department of Development. Shannon and the representative traveled to ABC Manufacturing to take a tour of the facility. It was noted ABC Manufacturing has paid 7 months of interest only payments. ABC currently has 58 full-time employees, 38 of the 58 are of low-income. Shannon delivered three grants to Columbus on June 25th: Formula, Neighborhood Revitalization and the Micro-Enterprise grant. Shannon will be working on Transit's grant; it is due September 1st, 2010. Mrs. Wells is concerned with the heating source at the new Transit facility. It was quoted \$10-12,000; for heat source and other modifications including installing a drop ceiling and bringing the building to code. Commissioners are not opposed to the improvements. Commissioner Reed inquired about Transit purchasing 2 new vehicles and how much money was in the Capital Account. Shannon replied there is currently \$40,000 in the Capital Account and Transit is going to purchase 2 new vehicles. Commissioner Reed asked if Transit could replace 2 large busses with vans. Shannon stated the Ohio Department of Transportation would allow

Transit to do that. Commissioner Reed further expressed the vans would be better on gas mileage and noted he has never seen more than 2 persons on a bus at one time. A discussion was held concerning the rubberized roof for the Senior Center's Formula Grant project. The project is under \$25,000 so it is not required to be put out for bid. A quote was submitted by Dwayne King in the amount of \$18,148; this is over 10% of the estimate for the project. The quote was rejected and the Development Office will be seeking additional quotes.

Stevan Hook, Engineer, asked if Commissioners had anything for him. Commissioners did not have anything at this time. Steve noted they are working on abutments for the Wagner Bridge. Commissioner Cain inquired if Steve checked out County Road 11 since Central Ohio Coal Company opened it back up. Commissioners Reed and Cain drove down County Road 11 and thought it looked overall descent. Steve replied he has been out there and noted it needs to be ditched better. A Public Viewing and Hearing needs to be set up for County Road 11 before the county accepts it back. The Public Viewing will be held on July 12th at 10:00am and the Public Hearing will be held at 1:30pm.

A Bid Opening was held in the Commissioner's Office at 11:00am for Issue I, Round 24- Motor Paving for County Road 4, part of County Roads 39 and 92, and Hanson Hill in Windsor Township. Those in attendance were: Commissioner Reed, Commissioner Reynolds, Commissioner Cain, Andrea Plummer, Commissioner's Clerk, Stevan Hook, Engineer, representatives from The Shelly Company, Shelly and Sands, Inc and Neff Paving. Commissioners inquired on the amount of miles to be paved. Steve replied: 15.8 miles. One Bid was received from The Shelly Company in the amount of \$925,217.80.

Two bids were received: Neff Paving in the amount of \$429,235.20 and Shelly and Sands Inc. in the amount of \$380,360.16.

Kaye Tatman donated a painting of the Courthouse to the Commissioners and requested it be hung in the Courthouse. Commissioners thanked Kaye for the work of art.

Commissioners signed the Host Agency Agreement for the Senior Community Service Employment Program, operated under Title V of the Older American Act between the Morgan County Commissioners and Washington Morgan Community Action Program.

Proclaiming Morgan County's support for the International Violence Against Women Act (IVAWA).

WHEREAS, every year, violence in the home and community devastates the lives of millions women and girls globally, a human rights violation that includes rape, domestic violence, acid burning, dowry deaths, so-called honor killings, human trafficking, female genital cutting and other harmful practices. The United Nations Development Fund for Women estimates that at least one out of every three women globally will be beaten, coerced into sex, or otherwise abused in her lifetime, with rates reaching 70 percent in some countries, according to the World Health Organization.

WHEREAS, existing United State foreign assistance programs focused on health currently have guidelines to address violence against women and girls, there is little information about what current U.S. international programs exist, nor systematic integration of best practices, and scant measurements of the programs' impact.

WHEREAS, more than 150 groups including U.S.-based N.G.O.'s, U.N. agencies and 40 women's groups across the globe have consulted on drafting of the International Violence Against Women Act (I-VAWA) to significantly increase U.S. commitment to help eliminate violence against women and girls globally by integrating anti-violence work across U.S. foreign assistance programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Morgan County, Ohio, joins with other sponsoring organizations and hereby proclaims its support of efforts to introduce and pass the International Violence Against Women Act (IVAWA) in the United States Congress.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Morgan County, Ohio, indicate its support by signing a letter of support to the Honorable George Voinovich, Senator, State of Ohio, urging his co-sponsorship of the bill, and permitting the logo of Morgan County, Ohio, to join the logos of other signing entities on that letter.

MaryAnn Chamberlain and Amy Grubbs, Morgan County Board of Developmental Disabilities, discussed combining their two levies to a replacement levy and have it be continuous. Gary Woodward, Auditor, and Stevan Hook, Engineer, was also in attendance. By doing this, there would be an increase of an additional ¾ mil to the taxpayer. Gary explained how the Board of DD’s levies are currently factored down and noted one of the levies is up in 2011 and the other is up in 2012 (one levy is a 5 year and the other is a 6 year levy). Commissioner Reynolds inquired on why they wanted to have the levy continuous. MaryAnn acknowledged by having the levy continuous it will keep them from having to coming back and putting a levy on the ballot and declared they will educate the public about the replacement levy and it being continuous. MaryAnn stated she can not see asking for less when they have a waiting list for services and noted they bring a lot of Medicaid dollars into the county. Commissioner Reynolds asked how many employees they have. MaryAnn confirmed they have 20 employees and some are part time. Commissioner Cain asked how many employees are from Morgan County. MaryAnn said a majority were from Morgan. Commissioner Reynolds inquired on the average wage for the employees. MaryAnn expressed employees start at minimum wage and if a position requires a college degree they are still paid lower than average. Commissioners personally support them having a renewal levy but do not feel they can support additional taxes on property owners due to the county’s unemployment rate and tough economic times. Commissioner Reed expressed he is concerned what happens if the levy gets turned down. MaryAnn honors the Commissioners opinions and stated she went 14 years in Washington County without going back to the taxpayers. She will take the information back to the board and noted they have a good record in the county.
