The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, August 2, 2010 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
The minutes of the July 26, 2010 meeting were read and approved.

10-310 Motion by Mr. Mike Reed and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from July 26, 2010.

Commissioners approved an application from AEP, to place poles on west side of County Road 66, located in Windsor Township, Morgan County, Ohio. The Construction of this project will begin on or about August/September 2010.

WHEREAS, the revised draft solid waste management plan was submitted to this Board (Council) for its review and approval in accordance with the ratification requirements of Chapters 343 and 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolve that the revised draft solid waste management plan for the Southeastern Ohio Joint Solid Waste Management District is hereby approved; and

The Streamlining Water Distribution Improvements Bid Opening for Community Development Block Grant Program FY2008 Distress was held in the Commissioner's Office at 11:00am. Those in attendance were: Commissioner Reed, Commissioner Reynolds, Commissioner Cain, Andrea Plummer, Commissioner's Clerk, Teresa and Kurt Montle, TAM Construction Inc., Terry Harmon, Zemba Bros Inc., Myron Callihan, Dreier & Maller, Scott Brown, McConnelsville Administrator, Maribeth Lemon and Diana Clifton, Genesis- McConnelsville, Lee Conkel, L-Con Engineers, and Traci Baker, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office. Two bids were received: Zemba Bros Inc. in the amount of \$418,670.69 and TAM Construction Inc. in the amount of \$484,500.00.

Della Bratton telephoned Commissioners to discuss continuous levies including ones for Morgan Local Schools and Morgan County Board of Developmental Disabilities.

Commissioners held a conference call with Randy Lambert, Attorney, Buckeye Administrators Inc., to discuss the lawsuit between the Board of Elections and the Commissioners relating to funding. Commissioners need to initially come up with \$10,000 for the Board of Elections.

Commissioners telephoned Judge Favreau and requested his presence in the Commissioner's Office to discuss year to date totals within the Courts appropriations.

Mr. Steve Hook, Morgan County Engineer, chaired a public hearing to appoint members to the County Sub-Committee for Issue I for Round #25. This was previously known as Issue II- Ohio Public Works. Those in attendance were: Mr. Dean Cain, Commissioner, Mr. Don Reynolds, Commissioner, Mr. Mike Reed, Commissioner, Mr. Steve Hook, Engineer, and Ms. Andrea Plummer, Commissioner's Clerk, and Scott Brown, Village Administrator- McConnelsville.

The committee is a 5 member group from the following government entities: 1 member from the Commissioners' office, 1 member from the Mayor's office, 1 member from the Township Trustees', 1 member from the County Engineer's office, and the 5th member to be chosen by the other four to represent the general public.

The 5th member will be chosen at a subsequent meeting, by the other four members, to represent the general public. Anyone interested in representing the general public should contact one of the Board Representatives. John McCort is interested in this position.
