The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, August 16, 2010 with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. The minutes of the August 9, 2010 meeting were read and approved.

10-328 Motion by Mr. Mike Reed and seconded by Mr. Don Reynolds to approve the minutes from August 9, 2010.

Becky Thompson, Dog Warden, reported traveling 126.7 miles responding to dog calls. Mrs. Thompson stated 4 dogs were impounded, 11 dogs were euthanized, 2 dogs were taken by S.P.O.T., and 2 dogs were redeemed.

Ancil King, Jr., Deputy Dog Warden, reported traveling 136.1 miles and 6.5 hours assisting the Dog Warden.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services, submitted a meeting request for Ginger Bowen on September 21st, to Athens, for "Fall 2010: Quarterly Fraud Control Meeting.

Kim Reed, Workforce Development, inquired on replacing some ballasts in the testing room; lights are flickering which makes it difficult on the individuals taking tests. Commissioners will get a hold of Jim Barnhart, Riecker/Courthouse Maintenance, and ask him to replace them.

Rick Fox asked Commissioners how to get a hold of Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office; Rick is interested in the Neighborhood Stabilization Program to tear down houses. Commissioners directed him to her office and informed Rick there is no money right now to tear down houses; however, Shannon may be taking names of interested person in case more money comes available.

Pam Montgomery, OSU Extension Office, updated Commissioners on Agriculture and Natural Resource, 4-H and Family and Consumer Science: the 10th Annual Ag & Livestock Field Day is scheduled for August 9th at Bruce Dozer's Farm; OSU Extension Office is currently accepting applications for Master Gardener Training. The 40 hour training will be on Tuesday and Thursday evenings beginning September 28 - October. Day long training is scheduled for Saturday, October 2nd. The cost will be \$60 which includes

refreshments, notebook and other material. To request an application, call the Extension office at 962-4854. The Farm Science review will be September 21-23. Discounted tickets for \$5 are available at the Extension office. The next grazing meeting is set for Thursday evening, September 16th at the Ed Kessler farm north of Malta. Call the Extension office for details. The Farmer's Market averages ten vendors per week. The monthly market basket giveaway has been quite successful with 100% participation from vendors. The Senior Coupon program has also been successful. Amy Grove is now serving on the Board of Rural Action and on the Advisory Committee for the Chesterhill Produce Auction. Buyers at the auction include Ohio University, the Wilds, Jo-Ad's Specialty Market, and several area restaurants and many other businesses and individuals. Master Gardener's working with Buckeye Hills RC&D on the Community Garden Program. Steering Committee will be meeting in August or September. 4-H Camp and Cloverbud Day Camp were both very successful in 2010. Pam thanks all the Camp Counselors and the adult volunteers that helped. Livestock Skilathons: August 19th at 6:00pm- Horse; August 21st from 7-9am- Feeder Calf and Dairy Beef Feeder pre-fair shots; Market Rabbit tattooing 8-9:30am; Beef, dairy and rabbits 8-9:30am; Sheep, swine and goats 10-1130am; Poultry and dogs noon-1pm. CARTEEN Program scheduled for August 24th, 6:30-8:30pm at the Courthouse. 12 teen drivers are scheduled for the program. Junior Leaders and Food Board are sponsoring a Recycle Day on August 21st, 10am-3pm. Individuals can bring plastic, glass and aluminum to be recycled. School enrichment programs are available to all the elementary schools for use in the 2010-2011 school year. Dining wit Diabetes dates set for 2010 are as follows: September 30, October 7th and October 14th, from 6:30-8:30pm at the Presbyterian Church on Liberty (individuals can contact the Extension Office 740.962.4854 to get their name on the list for the program); Helping Children Cope with Divorce is scheduled for Tuesday, August 31st (individuals can contact the Extension Office to register). The following is an update on the Family and Consumer Sciences programs: in July two programs were held for Women Infant and Children Program (WIC): the first program target audience was for young children with the focus on healthy eating for kids, the second program target audience was pregnant women with the topic being foods, beverages, or other substances that should be avoided during pregnancy. The ongoing program at Morgan County United Ministries (MCUM) - the topic was healthier food choices through food label reading. The Department of Job and Family Services is another ongoing program sit. The topic this month was food for good nutrition with the focus on how certain vitamins and minerals work with each other for optimal absorption. Programs scheduled for the remainder of August focus on small changes over time such as eating a three ounce hamburger verses a six ounce hamburger and adding physical activity to your daily life as well as unlocking the secrets of food labels. These will be presented to THE Kids Shop and Department of Job and Family Services. Pam noted Elaine Lindimore continues to do a great job with the program. The Convention and Visitor's Bureau (CVB) will have a booth at the Fair distributing information. The 2009 Economic Impact Study for Tourism in Morgan County, funded by the Governor's Office of Appalachia and the CVB, is complete. A copy was provided to the Commissioners. Commissioners are encouraged to contact Amy Grove with any questions. The regional and state studies are also available at the CVB office. Heritage Ohio and the Ohio Arts Council held a workshop at the Twin City Opera House on Tuesday, August 10th. The focus was funding for historic buildings, primarily theaters. Over 40 people were in attendance form all over the state. Amy Grove continues to represent Morgan County with Buckeye Hills RC&D as an at-large member and 2nd Vice President. Morgan County Master Gardener's were recipients of a \$600.00 mini-grant from the RC&D for the community Garden program and their revolving loan fund still has money to lend. The next Extension Advisory Committee will be held on October 11th, from 7-9pm.

A Public Hearing for Transit was held in the Commissioner's Office at 10:00am with the following present: Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, Commissioner Reed, Commissioner Reynolds, Commissioner Cain, and Andrea Plummer, Commissioner's Clerk. Shannon will be applying for the next round of funding for Transit.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, discussed the Neighborhood Stabilization Program and informed Commissioners the closing for the loan for Maxine Thomas for her Soup and Sandwich business occurred last Thursday. The new business is scheduled to open next Monday, August 23, 2010. Shannon stated she attended the 209 project meeting last Thursday, August 12th; and mentioned the new time clock system for Transit is working well. A discussion was held concerning the Senior Citizens Community Development Block Grant Formula 2009 roof project. Cost estimates were submitted by Dan McQueary, Hittle Roofing, and Dwayne King. There are three options with the roof: repair roof, take chimney down and gutter work. There are not sufficient funds to take care of all three. Commissioners requested they wait another week before they award the project.

Commissioner Reed informed Gary Woodward, Auditor, Morgan County's portion for the lawsuit between the Secretary of State and Diebold will be \$5792.50. Gary mentioned the Board of Election's Employee Salary line item will run out August 28th. A discussion was held concerning the lawsuit filed by the Board of Elections against the County Commissioners.

Dawn Rauch, Washington-Morgan Community Action, submitted a mortgage release to be signed by Commissioners. A discussion was held concerning a feasibility study for solar panels to possibly be installed on the Riecker Building.
