The Board of the Morgan County Commissioners met in their offices on Monday, December 20, 2010 with the following members present:

Mike Reed, President
Dean Cain, Member

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. The minutes of the December 13, 2010 meeting were read and approved.

10-531 Motion by Mr. Mike Reed and seconded by Mr. Dean Cain to approve the minutes from December 13, 2010.

Commissioner-Elect Tim Vanhorn was present for the Commissioners regular session.

Becky Thompson, Dog Warden, reported traveling 80.1 miles responding to dog calls. Mrs. Thompson stated 3 dogs were impounded.

Pam Montgomery, OSU Extension Office, updated Commissioners on Agricultural and Natural Resources: Master Gardeners will have their 2011 planning meeting and potluck meal on Wednesday, January 5th at 11am at the Morgan County Historical Society; Pesticide Training testing and re-certification dates are set. Training for new applications will be January 19th at 7pm at the Extension Office. Testing will be Tuesday, January 25th at 8am at the Morgan HS Vo-Ag room. OSU Extension will be hosting a five week in-depth training for beef producers on Thursday evenings beginning February 3rd. For more information, contact the Extension Office at 962.4854. Anyone interested in learning more about leasing property for the Marcellus and Utica gas fields, OSU Extension will have an educational meeting on February 16th at 7pm, at the Morgan HS Vo-Ag room. Reservations are required. Mrs. Montgomery provided a 4-H update: Older Youth have been interviewed for potential leadership roles for 2011; letters to 4-Hers accepted as Junior Fair Board Members and Camp Counselors will go out in the next week; individuals interested in being a 4-H volunteer in 2011 can call the office to request a new volunteer packer (interviews and orientation training are scheduled in January 2011); volunteer letters with the 2011 calendar were mailed out Friday, December 17th (current volunteers can call the office if they did not receive their letter); 4-H Advisory Committee is looking for new members. The committee consists of 4-H advisors, 4-H members and others. The committee helps 4-H professionals help plan, conduct and evaluate the 4-H program in Morgan County. Fashion Board has a make it/take it day scheduled for December 21st at the First Presbyterian Church from 9am-3pm to complete handbags they started in November. Letters will go to potential new Fashion Board members soon. Any 4-H member interested in learning to sew is welcome to be a member of Fashion Board. 4-H members or their parents can call the Extension Office to learn more about Fashion Board. Junior Leaders Holiday activity is scheduled for December 21st. Members will travel to Athens to eat dinner and ice skate at Byrd Arena. Mrs. Montgomery provided a Community Development update: Amy Grove, Program Assistant, is a new member of the Rural Action Board and serving on the Produce Auction Advisory committee; The CVB is involved now with selling the ads and approving the design of a new 2011/2012 Visitors Guide (should be ready by mid-January) and the new CVB website ought to launch about that same time. Mrs. Montgomery provided a Family and Consumer Sciences update: Helping Children Cope with Divorce is scheduled for January 31st, 2011 (individuals can call the Extension Office

to schedule for the class); the 2nd year for the Family Nutrition program grant is going well. Elaine Lindimore continues to offer programs at the following locations: Department of Job and Family Services, Morgan County United Ministries, Morgan County Office on Aging, Head Start, The Kids Shop and Women and Infant and Children.

Vicki Quesinberry, Director, Job and Family Services, submitted meeting request for Cheryl Bailey and Jody Murray to Athens on March 18th for "Assessing Dirty Homes....What's Too Dirty"; Cheryl Bailey to Athens on January 21st for "Gathering and Documenting Background Information"; Cheryl Bailey to Athens on January 11th for "Interviewing the Alleged Perpetrator"; Cheryl Bailey and Jody Murray to Athens on February 4th for "Electronic Evidence"; Kim Reed and Tina Work to Cambridge on December 20th for "Colgate Palmolive Company". Ms. Quesinberry submitted the software agreement with Maximus in the amount of \$2150.00 and informed the Commissioners union negotiations will start January 10th, 2011 at 9am.

Commissioners spoke with Jim Barnhart, Maintenance/Custodian, concerning the need to replace the light bulbs in the Community Room. Arrangements were made to rent a scissor lift and replace the bulbs.

Kelly Caldwell, Morgan County Humane Agent, inquired about a dog being dumped in the Commissioner's Office last week by Tammy Ray, Southeastern Ohio SPCA. Commissioner Reed stated Tammy Ray did drop off a dog in the Commissioner's Office; we were informed she picked up the dog near Poplar Ridge Road. Kelly questioned why Tammy Ray did not take the dog to their new shelter and hold it there until the Dog Warden could make arrangements to pick it up. Kelly further questioned if the Dog Warden had 72 hours to respond to a call. Commissioner Cain expressed that the Dog Warden does have 72 hours to respond to a call. Commissioners Reed stated he telephoned the SOSPCA and declared they are not to bring dogs to the Commissioner's Office. Dogs should be dropped off in the drop box at the Dog Pound or they could keep the stray in their licensed shelter and make arrangements with the Dog Warden to pick them up. The Commissioners are unaware of the reasons why the dog was dropped off in the Commissioner's Office. Kelly informed the Commissioners that SPOT is taking the dog that was dumped in the Commissioner's Office by the SOSPCA. Commissioner Reed mentioned the dog seemed to be a really nice dog and the Commissioners are thankful that SPOT is going to take the dog. Commissioners informed Kelly they appreciate her coming in. Kelly informed the Commissioners that she picked up a dog near Shrivvers Pharmacy last week, as a procedure she telephone the Sheriff's Department and Dog Warden informing them she had the dog. The owner called SPOT Friday night and claimed the dog.

Shannon Wells, Morgan County Commissioners' Development Office, acknowledged 90% of the Senior Citizen's roof is completed. Shannon stated there is \$2000 left of the Community Development Block Grant money that needs to be spent and questioned if it was ok to split the remaining funds amongst the Fire Departments. Commissioners are supportive of the suggestion. Mrs. Wells informed the Commissioners she and Traci Baker are taking the mortgage license tests online today. The tests are expected to take at least 3 hours each.

Gary Woodward, Auditor, spoke with Commissioners about the private pay premiums for employees that add their children age 26-28 to the county's health insurance plan.

Danny Dille spoke to Commissioners regarding the Friends of Lower Muskingum River applying for a grant from the Clean Ohio Fund to acquire approximately 60+ acres of forest land on the east side of State Route 60 approximately 1.5 miles north of the Village of McConnelsville. Danny asked the Commissioners to reconsider supporting them. Commissioners stated the biggest part of manufacturing is up that corridor. They would like to see the Morgan County Community Improvement Corporation purchase the lower 10-12 acres; the FLMR could apply for the grant to purchase the remaining acres. This would ensure available land for any future economic development in that area. Commissioners acknowledged the FLMR would like to purchase all the acres or nothing. However, the Commissioners hope to come to a compromise to benefit both parties. Danny thanked the Commissioners for their time and mentioned he would speak to the FLMR.

Larry Albert questioned postings at the Dog Pound and stated he did not think any dogs were in the pound. Larry asked Commissioner Reed to meet him at the Pound. Commissioner Mike Reed stated he would be willing to meet him at the Pound and told Larry to give him a call and let him know when.
