### **RESOLUTION**

#### **AUTHORIZING POLITICAL SUBDIVISION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act (AM. Sub H.B. No 100), as signed into law on December 4, 1985 and

WHEREAS, effective March 6, 1986, Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act provides the opportunity for counties, townships, municipal corporations, regional transit authorities, regional airport authorities or port authorities and school districts, conservancy districts, township park districts and park districts and other authorities, to

participate in contracts distributed by the state of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of Cooperative Purchasing for the purchase of supplies, equipment, and certain materials; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

Section 1. That the Morgan County Engineer, of Morgan County hereby request authority in the name of the Morgan County Commissioners to participate in state contracts which the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing has entered into and the Office of Cooperative Purchasing has distributed for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain other materials pursuant to Revised Code Section 125.04.

Section 2. That the Morgan County Engineer is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the Morgan County Commissioners to be bound by all contract terms and conditions as the Department of Administrative Services, Office of Cooperative Purchasing prescribes. Such terms and conditions may include a reasonable annual membership fee to cover the administrative cost which the Department of Administrative Services incurs as a result of Morgan County Commissioners participation in the contract. Further that the Morgan County Engineer does hereby agree to be bound by all such terms and conditions and to not cause or assist in any way the misuse of such contracts or make contract disclosures to non-members of the Coop for the purpose of avoiding the requirements established by ORC 125.04.

Section 3. That the Morgan County Engineer is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the Morgan County Commissioners to directly pay the vendor, under each such state contract in which it participates for items it receives pursuant to the contract, and the Morgan County Engineer does hereby agree to directly pay the vendor.

RESOLUTION/ORDINANCE MUST BE APPROVED, DATED AND FILED WITH THE OFFICE OF COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PRIOR TO USE OF A CONTRACT. ADDITIONALLY, THE PAYMENT OF THE APPROPRIATE ANNUAL FEE MUST BE MADE PRIOR TO CONTRACT USE.
