-Planning an Outreach Program with multiple entities throughout the community. Plan to make the focus on veterans. (no specific age) It was reported that they have already had their first planning meeting with the veteran groups and the outcome was great. Key players were brought together of veteran's services. The workgroup agreed to an event date of May 21, 2015 to be held at the Riecker Building. Service providers will be able to start setting up at 4:00pm., veterans and their families will be welcome to come and go as they please from 5:00pm-8:00pm. The vision is to hold a one night event where veterans can come to learn about supportive services in their community and to enroll in benefits they've earned. Attendees will be given free food (hamburger or hot dogs). Depending on the weather, other activities such as corn hole tournaments and rock wall climbing could take place. In addition to the table and booth services traditionally seen at resource fairs, we are also requesting to have mobile outreach units present. The mobile outreach unit from Wheeling for counseling services along with the VAMC's mobile outreach unit are two they are going to get scheduled for this event.
