The IT Director will be attending the Sunshine Law training class on Wednesday, 8 July 2015 in Zanesville. The goal of this training is to get some information on how e-mail and other forms of electronic communication pertain to the Sunshine Law and public record retention.

After much research, it appears that an online solution for disaster recovery (DR) is not going to work for the Auditor's office. These cloud-based services are going to be too expensive and are not exactly what the Auditor is looking for in a disaster recovery solution. A location needs to be identified that can be designated as a DR location where backup hardware can be installed.

Bomgar remote access solution was installed on the Auditor's server. Tyler Technologies was able to securely access the Auditor's server through the county firewall. This allows the firewall rules to be edited so that access to the Auditor's server on insecure protocols can be prevented.

The Genealogy room at the Courthouse called last week saying that they were unable to access the Courthouse's wifi. It is unclear whose wifi they were using, but the only wifi networks in the Courthouse are the Prosecutor's office and the Common Pleas Court. The Genealogy volunteers should not be using either one of those networks.
