Re: Fuel Bid Results to County Highway Garage

Only one vender (Greuey’s Fuel and Farm Supply, LLC), submitted a bid for supplying Regular Unleaded Gasoline and Low-Sulfur #2 Diesel Fuel under three option rates.

Those options are:

- 1.) Delivery to the County Highway Department only.
- 2.) Delivery to all others.
- 3.) Combining all locations at a single price.

**OPTION #1 – Delivery to County Highway Garage**

The diesel bids are based upon the “Average Rack Price” at the Marietta terminal “Oil Price Information Service” (OPIS) for the date of November 28, 2022 for Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel with an average **rack price of \$4.327 per gal. Fuel will be delivered for \$4.481 per gal** to the customer’s tank or designated location. **This creates a delivery cost of \$0.154 per gal., an increase of \$0.03/gal**

The gasoline bids are based upon the “Average Rack Price” at the Marietta terminal “Oil Price Information Service” (OPIS) for the date of November 28, 2022 for Ethanol (10%) gasoline with an average **rack price of \$2.1976 per gal. Fuel will be delivered for \$2.3076 per gal** to the customer’s tank or designated location. **This creates a delivery cost of \$0.11 per gal., an increase of \$0.019/gal.**

**OPTION #2 – Delivery to Townships or at pump in Malta**

The diesel bids are based upon the “Average Rack Price” at the Marietta terminal “Oil Price Information Service” (OPIS) for the date of November 28, 2022 for Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel with an average **rack price of \$4.327 per gal. Fuel will be delivered for \$4.601 per gal** to the customer’s tank, designated location, or pump in Malta. **This creates a delivery cost of \$0.274 per gal., an increase of \$0.05/gal**

The gasoline bids are based upon the “Average Rack Price” at the Marietta terminal “Oil Price Information Service” (OPIS) for the date of November 28, 2022 for Ethanol (10%) gasoline with an average **rack price of \$2.1976 per gal. Fuel will be delivered for \$2.4386 per gal** to the customer’s tank or designated location. **This creates a delivery cost of \$0.241 per gal., an increase of \$0.05/gal.**

**OPTION #3 – Combining everything into one price**

The diesel bids are based upon the “Average Rack Price” at the Marietta terminal “Oil Price Information Service” (OPIS) for the date of November 28, 2022 for Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel with an average **rack price of \$4.327 per gal. Fuel will be delivered for \$4.55 per gal** to the customer’s tank or designated location. **This creates a delivery cost of \$0.223 per gal.,**

The gasoline bids are based upon the “Average Rack Price” at the Marietta terminal “Oil Price Information Service” (OPIS) for the date of November 28, 2022 for Ethanol (10%) gasoline with an average **rack price of \$2.1976 per gal. Fuel will be delivered for \$2.4026 per gal** to the customer’s tank or designated location. **This creates a delivery cost of \$0.205 per gal.,**

**Conclusions:**

1. Combining will only increase the overall costs to the total county as well as the County Highway Department. It only makes sense to keep the delivery costs separated.
2. The only way to decrease delivery costs would be install a system that could handle bulk deliveries, meaning we would need a tank system that could hold at least 8,000 gallons. In today's regulatory realities; it is most likely not economical. This would require a separate detailed study itself.
3. Therefore since we do not have the ability to receive tanker bulk deliveries of diesel fuel or gasoline; I see no reason to not accept this proposal.

However, I think we should let each of the Townships individually decide if they are willing to accept this quote.

Re: Aggregate Bid Results

**Aggregate**

Four (4) companies submitted bids on thirteen (13) different aggregate materials (See attached list).

Shelly & Sands Aggregate was low bidder on the gravel products. Although we do not use a whole lot on gravel this will be our location to purchase any gravel products

The four companies submitted bids on the crushed stone portion of the bid request. When trucking costs are brought into the equation Sergeant Stone has the best overall delivered costs when "good" stone is required west of McConnelsville. If good stone is not a controlling requirement Cumberland Limestone has the best value.

Since job location, haulage costs, and job aggregate requirements will vary on a daily basis; **it is my recommendation that all the bids be accepted and usage will be based upon location and job requirements to obtain the most overall cost effective results for the materials and transportation to a given location.**
