- -Took 34 dogs from the pound
- -Accepted 104 dogs from owners in the county
- -Found homes for 25 cats not through MoCo.

-SPOT and MoCoKitty hosted Rascalunit mobile clinics 10 times in 2023 at a cost of over \$5200 each. Funding is about 1/3 from MoCo, 1/3 from dog owners, and 1/3 covered by SPOT for low-income owners. The goal is to stop production of unwanted puppies and kittens.

Average cost per dog at the clinic is \$95 for spay and \$85 for neuter, plus \$10 for the rabies vaccination. The pound fee does not cover the whole cost. Also SPOT provides parvo (6-way) vaccine for the pound.

- -167 owner dogs were fixed at SPOT clinics in 2023. We sent 20 owner dogs Dr. Whalin for spay/neuter between clinics.
- -SPOT also has an emergency pet food bank for Morgan County and we help out with parasite control products.
