Countywide Transportation Plan Proposal

- Proposal to seek \$200,000 in funding for a countywide transportation plan.
- Envisioned projects include developing an internal purpose trail network, which would support retaining the old iron bridge for trail access.
- Potential creation of ATV trails to connect state parks located in different corners of the county.
- Goal: a comprehensive transportation plan covering bikeways, hiking, and other modes.

Old Iron Bridge Funding and Status

- Plan to ask Senator Chavez for assistance in securing funding for the old iron bridge.
- The bridge does not currently meet criteria for ODOT's local major bridge project funds, but political pressure might expand eligibility.
- Approximately \$40,000 per year is spent on inspections.
- No major issues have been found to date; if a major issue is discovered, the bridge will be closed.
- Options include painting (around \$5 million), installing gates for flood events, or other measures.

Road and Bridge Project Updates

- **Compressor Road:** Bridge deck was poured on the day of the meeting; progress is strong due to favorable weather.
- **Winter Supplies:** 4,500 tons of cinders acquired; expected to last 5–10 years depending on weather.
- **Snow Response:**
 - Cinders are applied on top of snow, not preemptively.
 - Salt is used on federal roads and can be applied before snowfall.
 - One salt truck is kept ready at the garage for nighttime or weekend emergencies.

Floodplain Management and Permits

- 100 building permits and 21 floodplain permits issued this year.
 - Plan for next year: launch a voluntary campaign to collect resident information for the SWIFT 9-1-1 emergency notification system.
 - Enables sending flood alerts via cell phone.
 - All H&H (Hydrologic and Hydraulic) studies for the floodplain have been completed.

Chaundra Hopnsby, Concerned Citizen

A resident presents a detailed account to the commissioners alleging misconduct and abuse of power by the dog warden in an incident involving her elderly, disabled mother-in law and a stray male dog. The commissioners acknowledge the complaint, provide an initial official account of the dog's capture, and commit to investigate and follow up, requesting a written timeline via email.

Background: The Mother's Involvement with a Stray Dog

The concerned citizen recounts that her mother-in law first encountered two stray dogs in April near a hospital area, developed concern, and began feeding them after authorities were unable to catch them despite multiple attempts. She describes her mother-in law as someone who cares

deeply for animals and feeds starving dogs. The dog warden appears in the timeline on 5-15, and there is a related move noted on 5-18.

On 6-10, the mother-in-law attempted to lure the male dog to a secure area to assist in capture by others (referencing Becky and another woman), but coordinated efforts were unsuccessful. On 6-22, the mother formally adopted the male dog after being told the dog was found and would be saved; she paid fees, and concerned citizen questions whether those fees included spay/neuter. She notes her mother left multiple voicemails attempting to arrange timing, was told the dog would be obtained, and later emphasizes the male dog was not fixed. This background establishes the mother-in-law's intent to help, her formal adoption, and early administrative issues (communications and service inclusions) regarding the dog's care.

Escalation and Alleged Coercion by the Dog Warden

Following adoption, the concerned citizen narrates escalating conflict across the summer into November. She references July 4 and July 5 events involving a "female master" and a nursing mother dog (including efforts to put pills in food), while clarifying the subject dog is male. The core grievance centers on repeated, frequent ticketing of her elderly, disabled mother, difficulty catching the dog even by authorities, and what she characterizes as coercion.

The concerned citizen reports that on 11th (date as stated), the dog warden said she could not catch the dog. Within three days, another ticket was issued, and the concerned citizen says the dog warden indicated tickets could be given every day. She describes the mother-in-law as feeling intimidated, viewing the dog warden as "the law," and recounts additional ticket deliveries, including via an elderly gentleman who handled paperwork but did not fully understand it. It was also referenced 11-28 in connection with her mother-in-law being present and notes an interaction where ticket was issued.

It was stated the dog was described as mean and injured and raises a key allegation: that her mother-in-law was pressed to sign the dog over under the threat or expectation of euthanasia. She frames this as "coercion" and "abuse of power,"

The Dog's Capture, Disappearance, and Official Response

The concerned citizen questioned how the dog was ultimately caught and then allegedly disappeared. She reported that local women was able to catch the dog. It was then stated the dog disappeared out of a cage after capture.

The commissioners provided an official account: the dog was inside a chain-link fenced area, went through a gate to get inside, and the pound keeper caught him halfway underneath the fence. They noted that numerous reports had been received that the dog was a problem. The concerned citizen reiterated the dog had not been fixed, aligning with her earlier claim that unfixed males may exhibit such behavior. These conflicting narratives about the capture and the dog's subsequent disappearance reinforced the commissioners need to investigate.
